Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 -reg.

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi inspected M/s Bhabani Pigment Pvt., Ltd., Kharkhoda, Distt. Sonapat, Haryana (herein after referred as the Unit) on June 26, 2018 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, on the basis of short comings observed during inspection of the unit on June 26, 2018, Central Pollution Control Board issued technical directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the Unit on October 12, 2018:

WHEREAS, The Unit submitted the compliance status vide letter dated December 05, 2018 and December 24, 2018 w.r.t. directions issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the unit submitted performance adequacy assessment report of ETP from Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram University of Science & Technology, Murthal, Haryana vide letter dated 24.12.2018; and

WHEREAS, the unit was re-inspected on January 21, 2019 to assess the status of compliance of CPCB directions dated October 12, 2018 and it was observed that Unit has not completely complied with CPCB directions; and

WHEREAS, on the basis of short comings observed during inspection of the unit on January 21, 2019, Central Pollution Control Board issued closure directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the Unit on February 20, 2019 on the following directions

1. The unit shall upgrade its Effluent Treatment Plant so that it complies with the effluent discharge parameters prescribed by Haryana State Pollution Control Board and operate its ETP regularly. Zero Liquid Discharge compliance shall only be considered if the entire treated effluent is used in process and not in gardening / horticulture.
2. The unit shall discontinue the practice of storage of untreated effluent in huge open tanks/ lagoons at ETP premises.
3. The unit shall install flow meter at the ETP outlet and shall maintain proper records of reuse of treated effluent.
4. The unit shall provide proper colour coding to all the influent and treated effluent carrying pipelines in the ETP area.
5. The unit shall maintain proper records of solvent recovery / disposal of spent solvent, spent catalyst and spent acid.
6. The unit shall ensure that the emissions from the process area, after passing through adequate air pollution control system shall be discharged through proper vent / stack having adequate height and proper stack monitoring provisions.

WHEREAS, the unit vide letter dated March 04, 2019 submitted the notarised undertaking that it has closed its operations w.e.f. 03.03.2019 and has complied with directions issued by CPCB.

WHEREAS, the unit (M/s Bhabani Pigments Pvt. Ltd., Kharkhoda, Sonapat, Haryana) was re-inspected on April 18, 2019 to assess the status of compliance of CPCB directions dated February 20, 2019 and it was observed that Unit has closed its operations and has taken action w.r.t. CPCB directions; and

WHEREAS, Haryana PCB vide corrigendum dated 01.03.2019 has revised effluent standard of BOD from 22.5 mg/l to 30 mg/l and COD 131 mg/l to 250 mg/l of the Unit and;

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three-member committee vide office dated 03.10.2017 having representative(s) from CPCB and MOEF&CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three-member committee in its meeting held on 25.04.2019 examined the compliance report submitted by the Unit and recommended revocation of closure directions with condition that the unit shall submit performance assessment of the treatment system/ Air Pollution Control System including analysis of treated effluent/ emission by the same Government Institute (Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram University of Science & Technology, Murthal, Haryana) within 60 days; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, the closure directions issued to the unit (M/s Bhabani Pigments Pvt. Ltd., Kharkhoda, Sonapat, Haryana) under Section 5 of the

Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, vide letter dated 20.02.2019 are hereby revoked for a period 60 days with the condition that

- (i) the unit shall submit performance assessment of the effluent treatment system and Air Pollution Control System including analysis of treated effluent/ emission by the same Government Institute within 60 days.

In the event of failure to comply with the above stated directions, the revocation order shall automatically stand withdrawn and the closure order shall again become operative.

The Unit will ensure compliance with the norms. In case of non-compliance by the Unit, action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 shall be taken.


