Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 -reg.

WHEREAS, the Textiles & Dyeing industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting Industries which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

WHEREAS, a team of officers from the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi inspected M/s. New Garments, 200 HSIIDC, Barahi, sonapat (herein after referred as the Unit) on March 29, 2019 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, the inspecting team found the Unit operational and observed the following:

1. The ETP of the Unit was found non-operational during visit.
2. The Unit could not provide the consent under the Air & the water Act and Authorization for handling the Hazardous waste.
3. The Unit has not provided Air Pollution Control system to the stack of furnace using coke & saw dust as fuel.
4. Untreated effluent directly discharged in to nearby drain. The effluent Sample was collected and the analysis results of the outlet sample are w.r.t. parameters pH (9.14), TSS (179 mg/l), BOD (138 mg/l), TDS (4048 mg/l) & COD (364 mg/l).


WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body

or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit is directed to close all the plant operations with immediate effect and shall not resume its operation till following are complied with and written permission is obtained from CPCB:

1. The Unit shall operate Effluent Treatment Plant properly so as to achieve prescribed standards for effluent discharge.
2. The Unit shall provide Air Pollution Control System in the Furnace along with the provisions of source emission monitoring.
3. The Unit shall dispose its Hazardous waste in accordance with the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
4. The Unit shall obtain the consent under the Air & the water Act and Authorization for handling the Hazardous waste from Haryana State Pollution Control Board.

In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by Central Pollution Control Board.
