Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industry is identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Government of India, vide Notifications no. S.O. 157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, the unit, M/s. Neman Carpet (Formerly H.A.G. Carpet Industry), C-3&4, Industrial Estate, Mirzapur-231301, UP is a textile unit; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued directions dated 04.09.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to the unit to comply with following directions:

- 1) The unit shall resume operation only after obtaining valid consent from UPPCB and inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation.
- 2) The unit shall ensure regular OCEMS data connectivity with CPCB server and shall comply with stipulated discharge standards.
- 3) The unit shall submit performance audit report of ETP by reputed government institute within 60 days from resumption of operation.

AND WHEREAS, the unit has not submitted any reply/compliance in respect of CPCB directions; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued show cause notice dated 04.12.2018 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for non-compliance of CPCB directions; and

WHEREAS, the unit has not submitted any reply/compliance in respect of CPCB above directions; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 20.02.2019 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for non-compliance of above directions; and

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 08.03.2019 and 22.04.2019 were examined and following observations are made:

- 1) The unit has submitted valid consent to operate from UPPCB with validity upto 31.12.2019.
- 2) The unit provided regular OCEMS data connectivity with CPCB server.
- 3) The unit has submitted ETP Adequacy report prepared by IIT, BHU and as per report the capacity of the installed ETP is adequate for treating the effluent generated through dyeing operation. The overall performance of the ETP and the quality of effluent can be evaluated after resumption of operation.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB Constituted a Three-Member Committee vide office order dated 27/09/2017 having representative from CPCB, NMCG & MoEF & CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 25.04.2019 examined the performance audit report and while observing that IIT, BHU adequacy report says ETP system is adequate, recommended that:

- 1) The unit will implement recommendations of the report in time bound manner.
- 2) Performance audit report be submitted as per guidelines from IIT, BHU.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s. Neman Carpet (Formerly H.A.G. Carpet Industry), C-3&4, Industrial Estate, Mirzapur-231301, UP** is directed to comply with the following directions:

- 1) The unit may resume operation and upon resumption shall inform to CPCB about date of resumption of operation immediately.
- 2) The unit shall implement recommendations of the ETP adequacy report in time bound manner.
- 3) The unit shall submit performance assessment report of the treatment system including analysis of treated effluent by the same reputed government institute within 60 days of resumption of operation.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
