DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued directions on 24.02.2015, a follow up direction on 23.04.2015, and revised direction dated 07.12.2015 under section 18(1) (b) of Water Act, 1974 to Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board for ensuring that the molasses based distilleries including yeast manufacturing units in the state of U.P shall achieve zero liquid discharge, as per the options specified in the directions; and

WHEREAS, M/s The Mohan Goldwater Breweries Ltd., (Distillery Division), (hereinafter referred as 'the Unit') is involved in the production of beer using grain (rice, malt etc.) as raw material; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued show cause notice dated 03.05 2018 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit for installation of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and providing connectivity with CPCB server for data transmission within three months from the date of issue of the direction; and

WHEREAS, the unit has not replied to the show cause notice dated 03.05.2018; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 12.12.2018 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to close down manufacturing operations of the unit till installation of OCEMS and providing connectivity to CPCB in compliance of CPCB direction dated 12.12.2018; and

WHEREAS, the unit vide letter dated 04.02.2019 informed that the unit has installed parameters for pH, COD, BOD, TSS & flow meter and has provided the connectivity to CPCB. The same has been verified by the IT Division in CPCB; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted a Three –member committee vide office order dated 27.09.2017 having representative from CPCB, MoEF & CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB. The Three Member Committee in its meeting held on 11.04.2019 examined the matter and recommended for revocation with conditions as proposed by CPCB; and


1. The unit shall ensure uninterrupted connectivity of data transfer to CPCB server.
2. CPCB will impose environmental compensation for the period operate after closure direction

AND NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of powers delegated under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, direction dated 12.12.2018 issued to the unit, **M/s The Mohan Goldwater Breweries Ltd., is revoked herewith and the unit is directed to comply with the following directions;**

1. The unit shall ensure uninterrupted connectivity of data transfer to CPCB server.
2. As per Environmental Compensation policy framed in compliance of NGT order dt. 31.08.2018 in OA no. 593/2017. The unit shall deposit an Environment compensation amount of Rs. 62,40,000/- to CPCB A/c No. 532702050000164 (Bank name: Union Bank Of India, IP Extension Branch, Vikas Marg Extn., Delhi; IFSC: UBIN0553271) demand draft in favour of EC by CPCB towards environmental compensation for violating CPCB closure direction within 15 days from the date of receipt of the direction..
3. The unit shall inform CPCB about resumption of manufacturing operations immediately.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions or any other exigencies, CPCB will be constrained to initiate further stringent action against the Unit, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without any further notice.
