Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- reg.

WHEREAS, Pesticide units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by official of CPCB Regional Directorates, Kolkata on April 23, 2019 under OCEMS surveillance based on the offline of OCEMS during January 15 - February 15, 2019 and observed the following:

1. The effluent sample collected from ETP outlet solar evaporation pond (SEP) is not meeting the norms w.r.t BOD - $804 > 30$ mg/l, COD - $2787 > 250$ mg/l, Phenol $6.98 > 1.0$ mg/l and O&G $36.50 > 10$ mg/l is not meeting the norms notified under E(P) rules, 1986.
2. As such solar evaporation pond is not allowed as per E (P) rule, however water is getting evaporated and no discharge found during inspection.
3. It was observed that, OCEMS was defunct during inspection of the unit on April 23, 2019, Web Camera connectivity has not observed as per IT division report dated May 14, 2019.
4. The unit has not provided stack monitoring porthole and monitoring platform on the boiler stack.
5. Used chemical containers, poly bags and scraps were kept in scattered manner and housekeeping of the plant was not satisfactory.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.



NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit is directed to close all the plant operations with immediate effect and shall not resume its operation till following are complied with and written permission is obtained from CPCB:


1. The unit shall upgrade its Effluent Treatment Plant so that it complies with the effluent norms notified under E(P) rules, 1986. Zero Liquid Discharge compliance shall only be considered if the entire treated effluent is used in process and not getting evaporated by using solar evaporation system.
2. The unit shall discontinue the practice of solar evaporation system, shall dismantle the solar evaporation pond and install forced evaporator.
3. The unit shall provide stack monitoring facility on the boiler stack.
4. The unit shall store used chemical containers, poly bags and scraps in storage room in proper manner and unit shall improve housekeeping.
5. The unit shall confirm the connectivity of Web Camera as per guideline and ensure uninterrupted OCEMS connectivity with CPCB server.

In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action including imposing environmental compensation charges as per law shall be taken by Central Pollution Control Board under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
