Sub: Directions (Notice) under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg.

WHEREAS, the Fertilizer industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Unit (M/s National Fertilizers Limited, Village Vijaipur, Tehsil Raghogarh, District Guna, Madhya Pradesh - 473111) was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Bhopal on March 18 & 19, 2019 w.r.t. SMS alerts / offline status of Online Continuous Emission / Effluent Monitoring System and made following observations:

1. The unit is not complying with the effluent discharge standard prescribed for Nitrate N (14.28 > 10 mg/l).
2. Hazardous wastes like waste oil, alum and waste poly bags were stored in an area without impervious surface and proper arrangement for spillage collection.
3. The unit has not provided display board showing the quantity of hazardous wastes at the hazardous waste storage area.

WHEREAS, in reply of the said Show Cause Notice, the unit vide letter dated 02 May, 2019 submitted that it has taken corrective action w.r.t. observed shortcomings and also stated that it is complying with effluent discharge norms; and

WHEREAS, to verify the compliance, Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate Bhopal reinspected the unit on 16.05.2019 and observed that the unit has rectified the shortcomings that were observed during previous inspection on 18 and 19 March, 2019 and is complying with effluent discharge norms; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, (Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local


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body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of observed compliance, the directions (notice) issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit (**M/s National Fertilizers Limited, Village Vijaipur, District Guna, Madhya Pradesh**) vide letter dated April 23, 2019 are hereby revoked. The Unit shall ensure compliance to the norms. In case of non-compliance observed by the Unit, action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.


