**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 -reg.**

WHEREAS, the Textiles industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting Industries which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

WHEREAS, a team of officers from the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi inspected M/s. Sidhi Vinayak Apparels Pvt. Ltd., Sonipat (herein after referred as the Unit) on April 03, 2019 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, the inspecting team found the Unit operational and observed the following:

1. The Unit has not obtained membership from a Common Hazardous Waste Treatment Storage & Disposal Facility (CHWTSDF).
2. The pH meter and flow meter display was found non-operational during visit.
3. The ETP was operational during visit and sample was collected from ETP. The analysis results of effluent sample are not meeting the inlet standards of CETP w.r.t. parameter pH (12.05 > 6.5-9.0), TDS (3028 > 2100 mg/l).
4. The Unit has not provided the designated area for the storage of ETP sludge.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit is directed to close all the plant operations with immediate effect and shall not resume its operation till following are complied with and written permission is obtained from CPCB:

1. The Unit shall carry out adequacy assessment of ETP from reputed government institute and accordingly upgrade & operate ETP properly so as to achieve the prescribed standards.
2. The Unit shall obtain the membership from a Common Hazardous Waste Treatment Storage & Disposal Facility (CHWTSDF) and the Unit shall manage and dispose its Hazardous waste in accordance with the Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
3. The Unit shall repair the display of pH meter and flow meter.
4. The Unit shall provide designated area for storage of Hazardous Waste.

In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by Central Pollution Control Board.
