Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 -reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile (Dyeing) industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting Industries which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install and operate Effluent Treatment plant (ETP) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed thereunder and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Others dated 22/02/2017 directed that no industry which requires "consent to operate" from the concerned Pollution Control Board, is permitted to function, unless it has a functional effluent treatment plant, which is capable to meet the prescribed norms for removing the pollutants from the effluent, before it is discharged; and

WHEREAS, a team of officers from the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi inspected M/s. Kanodia Intercontinental Private Ltd., Sonipat Haryana (herein after referred as the Unit) on April 03, 2019 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, the inspecting team found the Unit operational and observed the following:

1. The analysis result of effluent sample collected from the ETP was found exceeding the inlet standard of the CETP prescribed by HSPCB w.r.t parameters pH (9.41 > 6.0-9.0), Sulphide (11.6 mg/l > 02 mg/l), TDS (3876 mg/l > 2100 mg/l).
2. The Inspecting team observed multiple outlets at the main gate and also observed flexible pipe which indicate bypass arrangement for untreated effluent.
3. The Unit has not obtained valid authorization under Hazardous and Other waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rule, 2016 from HSPCB.
4. The Unit has not obtained membership of TSDF facility for the final disposal of ETP sludge.
5. The Unit has not provided the separate room for temporarily storage of the hazardous waste.

6. The Unit has not maintained the log book for hazardous waste generation and disposal.
7. The Unit has dumped boiler ash at low lying area outside the Unit.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.


NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit (M/s. Kanodia Intercontinental Private Ltd., Sonipat) is directed to close all the plant operations with immediate effect and shall not resume its operation till following are complied with and written permission is obtained from CPCB:

1. The Unit shall carry out adequacy assessment of ETP from Government institute and accordingly upgrade & operate Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) properly so as to achieve prescribed standards.
2. The Unit shall immediately dismantle of the multiple outlets and also remove arrangement of flexible pipes from ETP.
3. The Unit shall obtain valid authorization under Hazardous and Other waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rule, 2016 from HSPCB.
4. The Unit shall obtain membership of TSDF facility for the final disposal of Hazardous Waste i.e. ETP sludge etc.
5. The Unit shall provide designated storage yard for temporarily storage of Hazardous waste.
6. The Unit shall maintain logbook for hazardous waste generation, storage and disposal.
7. The Unit shall ensure scientifically disposal of the boiler ash and maintain records of the same.

In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by Central Pollution Control Board.
