**Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986  
- Closure thereof**

WHEREAS, the Textile industry is identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries in the country and have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient water and air, which pose constant threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s Annapurna Carpet Private Limited, Village: Tikara, Post: Kakahara, Dist Mirjapur, Uttar Pradesh was inspected by a team from from Regional Directorate ( North), Lucknow on 21.03.2017 to verify the compliance of environmental standards. The inspecting team made the following observations:


1. The Consents under Water & Air Acts have expired on 31.12.2016 and thus unit was operating without consent. Hazardous Waste Authorization is valid upto November 2020.
2. The water requirement ( 283.5 M<sup>3</sup>/day) is met through ground water . The unit has not provided flow meters . The unit has not got permission from CGWA till date.
3. The unit has constructed ETP comprising collection tank, chemical dosing tank followed by tube settler & filtration. The sludge drying beds are not provided for sludge dewatering.
4. During the inspection, ETP was operational. Final treated effluent are discharged into river Ganga vis Pahari-Ojhla drain.
5. Unit has installed only flow meter at ETP and has not installed OCEMS for pH, SS, BOD & COD.
6. The unit has a coal/ husk fired boiler for meeting its steam requirement. About 1.5 tonne coal and 12 tonne Rice Husk is used per day.
7. No logbook is maintained by the unit for water withdrawal as well quality of water and treated effluent.
8. The inspection team collected sample of treated effluent and the analysis results for pH, colour, TSS, BOD, COD & TDS have been recorded as 7.58, 38, 27, 7.5, 50.7, 4392 mg/l respectively against the limit of 5.5-9.0,150, 100,30, 250 &2100 mg/l respectively.
9. The concentrations of TDS was found exceeding the limit of 2100 mg/l.

WHEREAS, Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, M/s Annapurna Carpet Private Limited, Mirzapur, Uttar Pradesh is hereby directed to close its operation immediately for the non-compliance as observed at Sr. Nos. 1,5 & 8-9 above.
