**Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding installation of on-line effluent and emission monitoring system - Show cause Notice**

WHEREAS, the Pesticide industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, pesticide unit M/s. Indogulf Croposciences Ltd., Sonapat (herein after referred to as the Unit) has installed online monitoring system (OCEMS) and provided connectivity to CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was randomly selected for inspection based on the SMS alerts generated from the OCEMS and inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Lucknow on June 05, 2019 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was found operational during the visit and inspecting team observed the following:

- i. The Unit has been operating without valid consent under the Water Act 1974, the Air Act, 1981 and authorization under the Hazardous and Other Waste Rules 2016 since September 30, 2018.
- ii. The Unit has been extracting ground water from the tube well without renewal of permission from Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA) since July 13, 2018.
- iii. The Unit has not provided electromagnetic flow meters at the inlet & outlet of Multiple Effect Evaporator (MEE) and records of MEE operation has also not been maintained.
- iv. The PM analyser and Oxygen sensor of incinerator stack was found out of order and displaying faulty values.
- v. The Unit has not provided proper ladder & platform at the incinerator stack.
- vi. The Unit has kept empty containers of raw material, which are hazardous in nature, in an open area.



WHEREAS, the online data connectivity has been verified from IT division and it was observed by the IT division dated July 02, 2019 that the Unit has not provided the flow meter connectivity to the CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, based on available facts and observations, in exercise of power vested under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, a notice is hereby served to the Unit (M/s. Indogulf Crosciences Ltd., Sonapat) to show cause as to why all manufacturing & production activities of the Unit should not be closed down until as the Unit is not complying as mentioned in the above observations

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which action as deemed fit under the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken against the Unit.
