Sub: Show Cause Notice under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS, the cement industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) has notified emission standards for Particulate matter, SO₂ & NO_x vide GSR 612 (E) dated 25.08.2014; and amended it vide GSR 496 (E) dated 09.05.2016 for all cement industries and vide GSR 497 (E) dated 10.05.2016 for cement industries carrying out co-processing of wastes in their cement kilns; and

WHEREAS, on request of cement industries, timeline was extended upto March 31, 2017 to comply with the aforesaid notified emission standards; and

WHEREAS, the matter regarding reconsideration of notified standards was taken up by the cement industries with the MoEF&CC and it was decided by MoEF&CC that general extension shall not be granted and any extension regarding compliance shall be based on due assessment and submission of clear/specific road map for compliance with notified standards in a time bound manner. Accordingly, Directions under Section 3 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 have been issued by MoEF&CC to CPCB on 28.03.2017 to ensure implementation of notified environmental standards for cement industries; and

WHEREAS, the cement industries were reminded vide letter dated 30.03.2017 that new notified standards for cement industries have become effective from April 01, 2017 and directed to submit clear/specific time-bound action plan for compliance with new notified standards before April 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, CPCB-RD inspected M/s Dalmia DSP Ltd., (Formerly M/s Kalyanpur Cement), Post-Banjari, Distt-Rohtas, Bihar on 13/06/2019 due to high number standard exceedance /offline status, generated from OCEMS and following observations are made:

1. As per manual monitoring at the stack attached with Rotary kiln of raw mill, PM emission (244 mg/Nm³) was found exceeding the emission norms of 30 mg/Nm³. High concentration of PM is attributed to poor operation and maintenance of bag filters.
2. Housekeeping of the unit is very poor. Fugitive emissions were observed all around the plant.
3. The unit needs to install display board at the main gate, displaying environment norms and HW generation/utilization

WHEREAS, the unit vide its letter dated 30.06.2019 received in CPCB on 03.07.2019 has informed that on observing high emission, the plant was stopped on 14.06.2019 and baghouse (1120 bags) have been thoroughly inspected and installed/replaced 300 bags and the plant was restarted on 26.06.2019 and now the stack emission are within the prescribed limits. However, no documentary evidence is submitted in support of the statements; and

WHEREAS the Ministry of Environment, Forests and climate change, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violation of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

Now, THEREFORE, in view of exceedance of emission norms and exercising the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, M/s Dalmia DSP Ltd., (Formerly M/s Kalyanpur Cement), Post-Banjari, Distt-Rohtas, Bihar is hereby directed to show cause as to why the unit should not be directed to close its operation.


The unit is given an opportunity to file its objection, if any, within 15 days from the date of issue of this notice. In case of failure, the Board will be constrained to initiate action as deemed necessary and appropriate under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
