Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- regarding

WHEREAS, Fertilizer Units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) to ensure installation of online emission monitoring system in Fertilizer industries for specific parameters for emission and effluent discharge in Urea Plants, CAN/NPK/Ammonium Nitrite Plants, DAP plants and SSP plants; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of Units with zero liquid discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Bhopal inspected M/s. Teesta Agro Industries Limited Khasra No 3936, 3931, 3938, 39381/ 4207 Village Gangrar, Tehsil Gangrar, District: Chittorgarh , Rajasthan (the Unit) on July 11, 2023 and observed that due to thunderstorm & lightening the data logger and other Online Continuous Emission / Effluent Monitoring System equipment of the Unit has been damaged and hence no data is not transmitted to servers; and

WHEREAS, it was observed that the Unit has not provided data of online continuous emission monitoring system for PM and fluoride parameters since June 18, 2020 as per report generated by the IT division of the CPCB on 24.08.2023; and

WHEREAS, CPCB Regional Directorate, Bhopal through Email dated 25.09.2023 informed that the Unit is in process of repair / replacement of Online Continuous Emission / Effluent Monitoring System equipment which may be completed by first week of November, 2023; and

WHEREAS the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers

vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit is hereby directed to comply the following directions:

1. The Unit shall provide connectivity of online continuous emission monitoring system for Particulate Matter and Fluoride parameter to Central Pollution Control Board within 3 weeks of issuance of this direction.
2. The Unit shall provide connectivity of online continuous effluent monitoring system for Flow parameter and shall provide online connectivity of web (PTZ) camera to Central Pollution Control Board within 3 weeks of issuance of this direction.
3. The Unit shall submit monthly stack monitoring data w.r.t HF & PM from NABL approved laboratories till the aforesaid online connectivity is made to CPCB server.

In case of failure to comply with the said directions necessary action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by Central Pollution Control Board.
