Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause an adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02. 1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Commercial Tannery, 94/80, Dargah Sharif Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh-208010 (hereafter referred as 'the Unit'), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to produce finished leather and discharge its PETP treated effluent for further treatment into CETP Jajmau; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 20.06.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to close down all the wet operations with immediate effect and obtain valid Consent to Operate from UPPCB, install adequate ETP & OCEMS, register with CPCB's industry Registration Portal and provide online connectivity to CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, the Unit reply vide letter dated 22.09.2023 was examined and the following observations were made:

1. The Unit has provided screenshot of its CPCB registration through online portal.
2. The Unit has submitted Self-Certificate regarding closure of the unit operations and a duly notarized Undertaking for compliance to all directions.
3. The unit has also provided the applications submitted for issuance of Consent to Operate from UPPCB.
4. The unit has submitted the Photographs of PETP.

AND WHEREAS, the data connectivity with CPCB server was verified by CPCB on 16.10.2023 and was found connected on RTDMS portal; and


WHEREAS, Three Member Committee for revocation in its meeting held on 04.11.2023 discussed the matter and recommended to issue the revoke directions to the unit subject to the following conditions as per the policy guidelines for issuance of directions;

1. The unit shall be permitted to operate for three months from the date of commencement of operation.
2. The Unit shall intimate the date of resumption of manufacturing operation to CPCB.
3. The unit shall obtain the valid Consent under the Water Act, Air Act, and Authorization under Hazardous & other Wastes Rules, 2016 issued by SPCB and shall not operate without valid Consents.
4. The Unit shall ensure uninterrupted data connectivity of OCEMS with CPCB server after commencement of operation of the plant.
5. The Unit shall ensure periodic calibration of the analysers as per Standard Operating Procedure/recommendations of the supplier and submit the calibration results.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Closure Directions dated 20.06.2017 is hereby revoked and the Unit, **M/s Commercial Tannery, 94/80, Dargah Sharif Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh-208010** is directed to comply with the following:

1. The Unit shall be permitted to operate for three months from the date of commencement of operation.
2. The Unit shall intimate the date of resumption of manufacturing operation to CPCB.
3. The Unit shall obtain the valid Consent under the Water Act, Air Act, and Authorization under Hazardous & other Wastes Rules, 2016 issued by SPCB and shall not operate without valid Consents and Authorization.
4. The Unit shall ensure uninterrupted data connectivity of OCEMS with CPCB server after commencement of operation of the plant.
5. The Unit shall ensure periodic calibration of the analysers as per Standard Operating Procedure/recommendations of the supplier and submit the calibration results.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions by the Unit, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
