Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 – reg.

WHEREAS, Fertilizer units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online emission monitoring system w.r.t. Urea Plants – PM, CAN/NPK/Ammonium Nitrite – PM, Ammonia, Fluoride, DAP plants – PM, Fluoride & SSP plants – PM, Fluoride parameters & online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, Ammonical Nitrogen, Fluoride & Flow parameters in Fertilizer industries; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of Units with zero liquid discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, a Show Cause Notice under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, was issued by Central pollution control board on July 24, 2015 to the **M/s Coromandel International Ltd., A/413, Industrial Area Nimrani, Dist.- Khargone, Madhya Pradesh** to show cause as to why the Unit should not be closed down if, the Unit has not complied fully with the directions issued w.r.t. installation of online emission & effluent monitoring system by June 30, 2015. Further it was directed to submit documentary evidence regarding status of installation and connectivity; and

WHEREAS, a team of officers from Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Bhopal inspected the unit **M/s Coromandel International Ltd., A/413, Industrial Area Nimrani, Dist.- Khargone, Madhya Pradesh** on June 22, 2017 based on SMS alerts during April, 2017 to May, 2017 for exceedance of Particulate Matter (PM) parameter in online continuous emission monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, It was observed during the inspection that the unit is zero liquid discharge unit and unit has not provided online connectivity of flow meter and web camera for continuous effluent monitoring as report by IT division, CPCB on August 01, 2017; and

WHEREAS, it was observed that the source emission of SSP plant stack of the unit is not complying w.r.t. emission standard of NO_x (68 mg/Nm³ > 50 mg/Nm³) as prescribed by Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board; and

WHEREAS, based on above observations, directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, were issued to the unit on August 09, 2017 to close all manufacturing / production activity until it complies with the directions mentioned therein; and

WHEREAS, the Unit vide letter dated August 13, 2017 submitted stack emission monitoring laboratory analysis report, valid consent to operate granted by Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board and requested to revoke the closure direction; and

WHEREAS, the unit vide email dated August 17, 2017 submitted the login details for connectivity of online continuous emission and effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has submitted an notarised undertaking on August 17, 2017 that the Unit has complied with all directions issued by CPCB and if plant is found non-compliant during verification by CPCB officials, the Unit accept to close down operations immediately and shall not operate till full compliance is achieved; and

WHEREAS, the connectivity of continuous online data for emission and effluent monitoring submitted by the unit was verified by the IT division, CPCB on August 23, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of undertaking submitted by unit under reference, the directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the **M/s Coromandel International Ltd., A/413, Industrial Area Nimrani, Dist.- Khargone, Madhya Pradesh** vide letter dated August 09, 2017 is hereby revoked. The Unit shall ensure compliance to the norms. In case of non-compliance observed by the Unit, action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
