DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued show cause notice for closure dated 30.07.2015 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to Show Cause why the unit should not to be closed if the unit has not complied fully with the directions issued w.r.t. installation of online effluent monitoring system and further directions to comply with; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated 22.07.2016 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, namely **M/s Dinesh Oils Limited, D-12, 13, 14 Site-III, PIA, Panki, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh** was not to undertake any operations till installation and commissioning of online 24x7 monitoring data to SPCB and CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has responded to the above said closure directions vide letter dated 11.11.2016, and submitted User ID, Password & URL, self certificate, registration and valid consent copy; and

WHEREAS, on considering the compliance of industry, CPCB hereby revokes the closure directions issued under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, subject to the condition that the unit shall ensure valid consent beyond 31.12.2016 and compliance of the norms before commencement of operations; and

WHEREAS, in view of the above on considering the compliance of industry, CPCB hereby revokes the closure directions issued on 20.01.2017 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, The unit shall ensure compliance of the norms before commencement of operations; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by the officials of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) on 26-05-2017 for verification of compliance and made following observations:

1. The unit was found closed during the inspection.
2. The unit was not in operation due to poor marketing conditions the unit has stopped operation.
3. The ETP consists of Equalization tank, Oil & Grease trap, Mixing sump (alum addition), Aeration tank-I, Tube settlers and Aeration tank-II, Secondary clarifier, Multi Grade filtration and activated carbon filter.
4. The unit has installed OCEMS at ETP outlet and connected to CPCB server. OCEMS was offline as the unit was not in operation.
5. No valid consent under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981, both consents expired on 31.12.2016.

6. The unit has applied for consent under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981 on 29.12.2016.
7. No authorization under Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Amendment Rules, 2016.


AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are issued:

1. The Unit namely **M/s Dinesh Oils Limited, D-12, 13, 14 Site-III, PIA, Panki, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh** shall remain closed and shall not restart its operation.
2. The unit shall obtain valid consents under Water Act, 1974 & Air Act, 1981 and Authorization under Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Amendment Rules, 2016 from UPPCB.
3. After completion of the above said measures, the Unit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of its manufacturing operations.

Failure to comply with above directions will attract action in accordance with the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
