DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986 FOR IMPOSITION OF ENVIRONMENTAL COMPENSATION

WHEREAS the Central Government has notified the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 and amendments thereof (herein after referred as BMW Rules, 2016) in suppression of the Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 1998, and amendments thereof, under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to improve the collection, segregation, processing, treatment and disposal of the Bio-Medical wastes in an environmentally sound management thereby, reducing the biomedical waste generation and its impact on the environment; and

WHEREAS Rule 5 of BMW Rules, 2016 stipulate duties of the operator of Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) to ensure treatment and disposal of biomedical waste in line with provisions of said Rules; and

WHEREAS as per Rule 7 (1) of BMW Rules, 2016, the bio-medical waste is required to be treated and disposed off in accordance with Schedule I and in compliance with the standards prescribed in Schedule II of the BMW Rules, 2016; and

WHEREAS Rule 14 (1) of BMW Rules, 2016 stipulate that every authorized person is required to maintain records related to generation, collection, segregation, storage, transportation, treatment, disposal and or any form of handling of Bio-Medical waste in accordance with these Rules and guidelines issued by CPCB"; and

WHEREAS the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, in the matter of O.A. No. 710 of 2017 filed by Shailesh Singh vide order dated 12.03.2019 directed "CPCB to undertake study and prepare a scale of compensation to be recovered from violators of Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016. Hon'ble NGT also directed that scale of compensation must be deterrent, rendering violation of Rules to be non-profitable which should be adequate to remedy the situation"; and

WHEREAS Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in its order dated 15.07.2019 in the matter of O.A. No. 710 of 2017, accepted Guidelines for "Imposition of Environmental Compensation Charges (ECC) against Healthcare Facilities (HCFs) and Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facilities (CBWTFs)"; and

WHEREAS the CBWTF namely M/s Belgaum Green Environment Management Pvt. Ltd., Sy. No. 29/2, Harugoppa Village, Saundatti Taluk, Belagavi District, Belagavi, Karnataka (the Unit) was inspected by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) on 19.07.2023 and based on non-compliances

observed during inspection, CPCB issued Show Cause Notice under section 5 of Environment (Protection) act, 1986 against the Unit vide letter dated 27.09.2023 for violation of provisions under BMWM Rules, 2016 and directed to take corrective measures and submit the time bound action taken report and explain why Environmental Compensation Charges should not be imposed for violation of provisions of BMWM Rules, 2016.

WHEREAS in response to the aforesaid Show Cause Notice the Unit submitted its reply vide letter dated 09.10.2023. While examining the response, the Unit was found non-complying with respect to following points;

- a) As per stack monitoring results, Particulate matter ($117\text{mg}/\text{Nm}^3$) exceeds the prescribed standard ($50\text{mg}/\text{Nm}^3$) of BMWM Rules, 2016.
- b) Manual segregation of biomedical waste was observed at the facility.

As per CPCB guideline, Environmental Compensation Charges has been assessed as ₹4,72,500/- (From date of inspection i.e. 19.07.2023 to till date i.e. 21.11.2023)

WHEREAS the Central Government vide notification S.O. 730 (E) dated July 10, 2002, has delegated the powers under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue directions for violation of the standards and rules relating to Biomedical Waste Management notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit is hereby directed to:

- I. Take immediate necessary measures ensuring compliance of the prescribed emission standards in incinerator and stop manual segregation of bio-medical wastes. Compliance status in this regard be immediately submitted with relevant documents, stack emission results from lab recognized under EPA 1986, etc., as applicable.
- II. Deposit Environmental Compensation Charges of ₹4,72,500/- (as on 21.11.2023) in CPCB account No. 532702050000164 IFSC code UBIN0553271, I.P. Extension Branch within 15 days on receipt of this direction.

In case the Unit fails to comply with above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action against M/s Belgaum Green Environment Management Pvt. Ltd., Sy. No. 29/2, Harugoppa Village, Saundatti Taluk, Belagavi District, Belagavi, Karnataka, under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
