Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries have been identified as one the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPI) which have been discharging effluents directly or indirectly on land and into water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on land and the ambient water quality; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & control of pollution) Act, 1974 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all 11 Ganga Basin State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committee (PCC) for installation of online effluent monitoring system w.r.t. pH, BOD, TSS, COD and flow parameters in Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of units with Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, considering the requests/representations received from industries/industrial associations /SPCBs/PCCS, an extension of time up to June 30, 2015 for installation of online monitoring systems was granted vide direction dated March 27, 2015 under section 18 (1) (b) of Water (Prevention & control of pollution) Act, 1974; and

WHEREAS, a letter vide dated May 29, 2015 was issued to the Chairman CPCB to all the SPCBs/PCCS informing that no further extension of time will be given after June 30, 2015 and withdrawal of consents to operate along with forfeiture of bank guarantee of non-complying Units will be the only option; and

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WHEREAS, the unit M/s Pasupati acrylon Ltd., Kashipur Road, Thakurdwara, Distt. Moradabad, Uttar Pradesh is a textile industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 11.04.2017 to verify the compliance status; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dated June 13th, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to comply with the following:

- 1) The unit shall be closed with immediate effect and not resume till:
 - i) The unit obtains the consent to operate (renewal) under Air Act and HW authorization from the State Pollution Control Board.
 - ii) The unit takes effective steps to stop direct/indirect discharge of effluent into the river system.
 - iii) The unit revamps the existing ETP with tertiary/membrane treatment system and operates/maintains ETP scientifically so as to meet the notified standards and ensure ZLD scheme.

WHEREAS, unit replied vide letter dated 14.08.2017 & 21.08.2017 in respect of closure direction that:

- i) The unit has installed web camera and connected the same to CPCB server and has also registered to the CPCB portal.
- ii) The unit has an air and water consent valid upto 31.12.2107 and HW authorization valid upto 11.02.2021, the copies of which are enclosed along with the representation.
- iii) The unit is not discharging any effluents directly or indirectly into the river system. The treated effluent is fully recycled and reused in the process.
- iv) The unit states that it is treating the effluents to tertiary levels through bioremediation technology. The detailed performance evaluation of the treatment units has been initiated by the industry.

AND NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, M/s Pasupati acrylon Ltd., Kashipur Road, Thakurdwara, Distt. Moradabad, Uttar Pradesh is **allowed to resume its manufacturing operations** subject to the following condition;

- i. The unit shall ensure that the installed online monitoring devices are functioning properly and continuously and data from the devices are uninterruptedly transferred to CPCB. Any failure in this regard shall be intimated to CPCB with reasons thereof and shall be rectified at the earliest.
- ii. The unit shall ensure the proper operation of the ETP so as to achieve the prescribed standards.
- iii. The detailed performance evaluation report of the treatment process shall be submitted to CPCB within 30 days from the date of receipt of these directions.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions or any other exigencies, CPCB will be constrained to initiate further stringent action against the Unit, **M/s Pasupati acrylon Ltd., Kashipur Road, Thakurdwara, Distt. Moradabad, Uttar Pradesh** in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without any further notice.
