DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986 AND SHOW CAUSE NOTICE - THEREOF FOR IMPOSITION OF ENVIRONMENTAL COMPENSATION

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 and amendments thereof (herein after referred as BMWM Rules, 2016) in suppression of the Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 1998, and amendments thereof, under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to improve the collection, segregation, processing, treatment and disposal of the Bio-Medical wastes in an environmentally sound management thereby, reducing the biomedical waste generation and its impact on the environment; and

WHEREAS, Rule 5 of BMWM Rules, 2016 stipulate duties of the operator of Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) to ensure treatment and disposal of biomedical waste in line with provisions of said Rules; and

WHEREAS, as per Rule 7 (1) of BMWM Rules, 2016, the bio-medical waste is required to be treated and disposed-off in accordance with Schedule I and in compliance with the standards prescribed in Schedule II of the BMWM Rules, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Rule 14 (1) of BMWM Rules, 2016 stipulate that every authorized person is required to maintain records related to generation, collection, segregation, storage, transportation, treatment, disposal and or any form of handling of Bio-Medical waste in accordance with these Rules and guidelines issued by CPCB"; and

WHEREAS, the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, in the matter of O.A. No. 710 of 2017 filed by Shailesh Singh vide order dated 12.03.2019 directed "CPCB to undertake study and prepare a scale of compensation to be recovered from violators of Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016. Hon'ble NGT also directed that scale of compensation must be deterrent, rendering violation of Rules to be non-profitable which should be adequate to remedy the situation"; and

WHEREAS, Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in its order dated 15.07.2019 in the matter of O.A. No. 710 of 2017, accepted Guidelines for "Imposition of Environmental Compensation Charges (ECC) against Healthcare Facilities (HCFs) and Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facilities (CBWTFs)"; and

WHEREAS, the CBWTF namely M/s. Champawati Waste Management is located at Sr. No. 282/307, Post - Pali, Tal. and District Beed, Maharashtra (the Unit) was inspected by Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) on 25.08.2023 wherein following non-compliances were observed:

- i. As per analysis result of stack emission monitoring, concentration of Particulate Matter (60 mg/m³) exceeds the standards of particulate matter (50 mg/m³) prescribed under BMWM Rules, 2016.
- ii. As per Analysis result of treated effluent, pH (4), SS (342 mg/l), BOD (725 mg/l), COD (1720 mg/l), oil & grease (11.6 mg/l) exceeds the prescribed standards of pH (6.5-9.0), SS (100 mg/l), BOD (30 mg/l), COD (250 mg/l) and O&G (10 mg/l), respectively. The treated effluent is used in quencher and scrubber.
- iii. Treated glass waste not disposed-off through authorised glass recycler.
- iv. Display board provided is not as per consent issued by State Board under Water & Air Act indicating emission & effluent parameters, solid waste data and hazardous waste data.
- v. Separate spacing not provided for storage of incinerator ash and ETP sludge.
- vi. Log books not maintained properly for incinerable waste


WHEREAS, as per the CPCB guidelines for "Imposition of Environmental Compensation Charges (ECC) against Healthcare Facilities (HCFs) and Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facilities (CBWTFs)", the Environment Compensation for above mentioned non-compliances at S. No. i) to ii) at the rate of ₹ 3,000/- per day; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government vide notification S.O. 730 (E) dated July 10, 2002, has delegated the powers under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue directions for violation of the standards and rules relating to Biomedical Waste Management notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit is hereby directed to:

- a. Take corrective measures immediately and submit the action taken report within 15 days from the issue of this direction along with supporting documents & photographs; and
- b. Show Cause as to why Environmental Compensation Charges of ₹ 3,000/- per day should not be imposed, as per the CPCB guidelines for violation of effluent discharge standards as prescribed under BMWM Rules, 2016.

In case the Unit found non-complying with above directions, CPCB will be constrained to take legal proceedings against M/s. Champawati Waste Management is located at Sr. No. 282/307, Post - Pali, Tal. and District Beed, Maharashtra, as deemed fit under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
