Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding installation of on-line effluent and emission monitoring system.

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Syn Finechem Laboratories Pvt. Ltd., Telangana (herein after referred as the Unit) has installed online monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, the Online effluent Monitoring system of the Unit was in offline mode during the month of April-May 2017; and

WHEREAS the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Bangalore on July 26, 2017 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system, observations of team are as follows:

1. The Unit has not provided the water meter to verify the quantity of water consumed and also not maintained the log book.
2. The Unit has not segregating the HTDS & LTDS streams as per the consent issued from the Telangana State Pollution Control Board however the solvent generated from the process is pumped to the syntax tanks through flexible pipes.
3. The Unit has not provided the proper labelling to the solvent storage area and not provided boundary wall to collect the spillages.
4. The containers and used drums are kept haphazardly and these drums are sold to recyclers without detoxification.
5. The Unit has not provided the proper space for the storage of hazardous waste as it was stored near the wood fired boiler.
6. The Unit has not installed the online pH monitoring system for the scrubber as per the consent and also not provide the log books.
7. The unit has not provided any emission monitoring device to monitor the nature of emission discharged by the stack.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are being issued:

- 1) The Unit shall remain closed and shall not resume till following are complied;

- i. The Unit provides the water meter to verify the quantity of water consumed and also maintains the log book.
- ii. The Unit segregates the HTDS & LTDS streams as per the consent issued from the Telangana State Pollution Control Board and provides proper system for the transfer & collection of effluent.
- iii. The Unit provides the proper labelling to the solvent storage area and provides boundary wall to collect the spillages.
- iv. The Unit provides proper space for the storage of containers and used drums and detoxifies the drums as per the consent before further process.
- v. The Unit provides proper storage space for the Hazardous waste.
- vi. The Unit install the online pH monitoring system for the scrubber as per the consent and also provides the log books.
- vii. The Unit provides emission monitoring device to monitor the nature of emission discharged by the stack.

The Unit M/s. Syn Finechem Laboratories Pvt. Ltd., Telangana shall submit the compliance report for the direction at point (1) above immediately on receipt of direction. Failure to comply with the above directions will attract action in accordance with the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
