Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- reg.

WHEREAS, the Petrochemical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, a show cause notice under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 was served to the unit on March 02, 2017 to show cause as to why the Unit be not directed to close all manufacturing / production activities until comply with the following directions:

1. The Unit shall have valid consent for operation.
2. The Unit shall install fugitive emission of BTX analyzer instead of VOC analyzer.
3. The Unit shall provide proper ladder for approach to sampling platform as per CPCB Emission Regulation Part III 1985.
4. The industry shall respond to SMS alerts generated with an acknowledgement followed by rectification and again informing about the rectification.
5. The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to achieve prescribed standard.
6. The KSPCB shall stipulate and modify single standards for source emission standards instead of two standards.

WHEREAS in response to the show cause notice, the unit vide letter dated April 10, 2017 submitted that compliance has been achieved as per the CPCB direction; and

WHEREAS the unit was re-inspected on July 11, 2017 by RD, Bangalore to verify the compliance of CPCB direction; and

WHEREAS as per inspection report provided by the RD, Bengaluru dated August 09, 2017, it was observed that the unit has complied with all points; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of observed compliance, the directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the M/s ONGC Mangalore Petrochemicals Ltd., Permude Village Phase-1 project, Mangalore, Karnataka vide letter dated March 02, 2017 is hereby revoked. The Unit shall ensure compliance to the norms. In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
