Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of Units with Zero liquid discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install Effluent Treatment Plants (ETPs)/ Primary effluent treatment plants (PETPs) to comply with the effluent discharged standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, M/s Pahalwan Tanney (Unit-II), 2-A, Gajju Purwa, Jajmau, Kanpur-208010 (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is processing of raw hides to produce finished leather by chrome tanning; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by the officials of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) on 31-05-2017 and observed the following:

1. At the time of inspection, Unit was found operational.
2. Overall housekeeping in process area and PETP was observed satisfactory.
3. The OCEMS has been installed and connected to the CPCB server.
4. The unit has installed electromagnetic flow meters at borewell and PETP outlet.
5. The unit has submitted application for seeking permission of CGWA for groundwater withdrawal.
6. The PETP consists of Collection sump, Chemical dosing tank, settling tank, sludge drying beds.
7. The unit has valid consent under Water Act, 1974 valid upto 31.12.2017 and authorizations of HWM upto 31.12.2021.

- Unit was found non-complying w.r.t. prescribed discharge standards as PETP outlet sample analysis shows pH: 6.06 against the prescribed limits of 6.5-9.0 and Cr (T): 14.7 mg/l against the prescribed limits of 2.5 mg/l.

It is evident from the results that the Unit is not meeting with the prescribed effluent discharge standards with respect to pH- 6.06 (against 6.5-9.0) and Cr (T)- 14.7(against 2.0 mg/l).

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the following directions are being issued:

- The Unit shall close all the plant operations with immediate effect.
- The Unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations in compliance of the direction immediately on receipt of this direction.
- The Unit shall take adequate measures to meet the pH & Cr (T) as per prescribed standards.
- After completion of the above said measures, the Unit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of their manufacturing operations.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
