Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-reg

WHEREAS, Pesticide units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality;

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, Show Cause Notice under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, was issued on July 22, 2015 to all Pesticide units w.r.t. installation of online emission & effluent monitoring system and directed to submit documentary evidence regarding status of installation and connectivity; and

WHEREAS, the unit has informed vide E-mail dated 07.09.2016, 04.10.2016 and 15.02.2017 regarding confirmation of OCEMS connectivity to CPCB Central Server; and

WHEREAS, in the monthly review of online data during November 15- December 15, 2016 from 17 category industries it was observed that the Unit (M/s Tagros Chemicals India Ltd) was found OFFLINE; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by official of CPCB Regional Directorate, Bengaluru on 20.01.2017 regarding on-line Continuous Effluent / Emission Monitoring System (OCEMS) under offline status and show cause Notice Issued dated March 16, 2017 to comply with the following direction;

- I. The unit shall obtain consent for air & water form TNPCB.
- II. The unit shall operate ETP properly to comply with the prescribed standard for TSS, BOD, COD, O&G, TDS, Chloride, Ca & TKN.
- III. The unit shall provide port hole as per CPCB Guideline to verify the online monitoring data.
- IV. The unit shall store high TDS effluent in the tank above ground level.
- V. The unit shall connect OCEM to CPCB central portal.

WHEREAS, the unit (M/s Tagros Chemicals India Ltd) has submitted reply against Show Cause Notice on 06.06.2017; and

WHEREAS, RD Bengaluru inspected the unit on 07.06.2017 for Compliance of show cause Notice and found that The unit is complying with four points i.e. 1,3,4 and 5 of the notice and point 2 is partially complied i.e the effluent sample collected at the RO Reject w.r. TSS: 118 > 100 mg/l, BOD: 133 > 30 mg/l COD: 337 > 250 mg/l, Ca: 38.9 > 2 mg/l are not meeting with the prescribed standards by TNPCB.

WHEREAS, unit (M/s Tagros Chemicals India Ltd) has submitted reply on July 31, 2017 that following steps have been taken after the last visit of CPCB.

- I. 5 micron Cartridge filter installed and the RO reject passes through this for reducing the pollutants.
- II. Added one spiral RO which will treat the RO reject from the 5 micron cartridge filter before discharging the marine disposal by which pollutants may further reduced.

WHEREAS, Unit has submitted the Affidavit on August 01, 2017 stating that they have complied all the directions issued by the CPCB and in case, during verification by CPCB officials, if there plant is found non compliant they accept to close down the industry immediately and to not operate till full compliance achieved.


WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of the compliance of above directions and the affidavit produced by the unit, the directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to M/s Tagros Chemicals India Ltd vide letter dated July 26, 2017 is hereby revoked. In case of non-compliance by the unit, action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
