**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, Textile dyeing and bleaching industries have been identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality and;

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide its notification S.O.157(E) dated 27.02.1996, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue directions to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board, any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and other standards and norms; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Super Dyeing & Printing Works, NH-24, Delhi-Hapur Road, Pilakhuwa, Hapur, U.P-245304 (hereafter referred to as the 'unit') is a textile unit; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued Show Cause Notice for closure dated 21.06.2016 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to show cause why the unit should not be closed down if the unit has not complied fully with the direction issued by SPCB in compliance to the direction issued by CPCB under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 in respect of GPI w.r.t. installation of OCEMS system by 30.06.2015; and

**WHEREAS**, no response has been received from the units; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued closure direction dated 15.05.2017 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to close down wet operations till the installation of OCEMS and providing connectivity to CPCB server; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit was inspected by a team of CPCB officials and found the unit is not meeting with the prescribed effluent discharge standard w.r.t BOD-40 mg/l (against norms of 30 mg/l); TSS - 240 mg/l (against norms of 100 mg/l) and non-installation of OCEMS; and

**WHEREAS**, CPCB issued following direction dated 20.06.2017 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit:

1. The unit shall close down all the manufacturing operations with immediate effect.

2. The unit shall obtain valid consent from UPPCB under Air and Water Acts.
3. The unit shall install electromagnetic flowmeters at all water withdrawal points and obtain NOC from CGWA.
4. The unit shall install online monitoring system immediately and maintain data connectivity with CPCB.
5. After completion of the above said measures, the unit shall report to CPCB and seek permission from CPCB before resumption of their manufacturing operations

**WHEREAS**, in response to the closure direction issued by CPCB, the unit submitted replies dated 07.07.2017 & 15.09.2017. After examining the replies, a letter dated 15.09.2017 was issued to the unit to submit the requisite documents for initiating the revocation process; and

**WHEREAS**, the unit reply dated 28.09.2020 (by email) was examined and following observations were made:

1. The unit was still non-operational.
2. The unit submitted self-certificate in prescribed format.
3. The unit provided the copy of application seeking Consent to operate for dry process applied to UPPCB.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB constituted a Four-Member Committee having representative from CPCB, NMCG and MoEF & CC for examination and recommendation for revocation of the closure direction issued by CPCB; and

**WHEREAS**, the Four Member Committee in its meeting held on April 07, 2021 examined the replies of the unit and recommended for revocation of directions dated 15.05.2017 and 20.06.2017 issued under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 with following conditions:

1. The unit may be allowed for dry operations subject to condition that the unit will obtain Consent to operate for dry operations; from UPPCB.

**AND NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit, **M/s Super Dyeing & Printing Works, NH-24, Delhi-Hapur Road, Pilakhuwa, Hapur, U.P-245304** is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit may resume dry operations subject to condition that the unit will obtain consent to operate for dry operation; from UPPCB.
2. The unit may operate on dry process only and shall not operate any wet process to generate or discharge any wastewater.
3. The unit will inform CPCB immediately after resuming operation.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
