Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986-- Show cause Notice

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, Pharmaceutical unit, M/s Malladi Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Ltd., Ranipet, Tami Nadu (herein after referred to as the unit) was randomly selected for inspection based on the SMS alerts generated through the OCEMS installed at the unit, and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate Chennai on February 16, 2021 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and observed the following shortcomings:

1. The Consent to Operate (CTO) of the unit is valid upto 31.03.2021.
2. The effluent analyser settings verification was also carried out and observed that COD, TSS values displayed at the OCEMS is much lower than the values displayed at the local dash board and TPDS portal.
3. The unit has not installed PTZ camera and OCEMS analyser are not displaying proper data.
4. The unit has not obtained HW Authorisation for the generation & disposal of spent solvent residue generated from the process. The spent solvent residue & re-processing materials are kept stored in the open yard.
5. The unit has stopped bio composting process before September 2020, but the bio compost is still kept in the open yard without any covering.
6. The yeast sludge generated was used along with press mud for bio composting, which is violation of consent condition of Tamil Nadu State Pollution Control Board.

M/s Malladi Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Ltd., Tami Nadu

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and climate change, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, a notice is hereby served to the unit M/s Malladi Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Ltd., Ranipet, Tami Nadu to show cause why the unit should not be closed down as the unit is not complying with respect to the above mentioned observations of the inspecting team.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above directions within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which action as deemed fit under the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 will be taken by CPCB.
