DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest, & Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board, to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 & other standards and norms; and

WHEREAS, M/s Oriental Textile Processing Co. Pvt Ltd., Link Road, Samrala Bypass, Ludhiana East, Ludhiana (hereafter referred to as 'the Unit') is a textile (dyeing & washing) plant; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by a team of officials from CPCB on 24.06.2021 to verify the compliance status under surprise inspection programme and made following observation:

1. The Unit was operational during the visit. The Unit has facility for dyeing, washing and printing of knitted cloths.
2. The "Consent to operate" (CTO) under Water Act, Air Act and *Authorisation* under Hazardous & other Rules, 2016 is valid upto 31.03.2024, 31.06.2022 and 30.06.2022 respectively.
3. The ETP was operational during the visit. The ETP comprises of mesh screens-reactor channel, DAF, MBBR, Sand filter and Carbon filters.
4. During inspection, samples were collected from the ETP final outlet and lab analysis results showed: pH-7.4 (norms-6.5-8.5), TSS-68 mg/l (norms-100 mg/l), COD-274 mg/l (norms-250 mg/l), BOD-47 mg/l (norms-30 mg/l), TDS-4484 mg/l (norms-2100 mg/l); SAR-52 (norms-26) and Cr-BDL (norms-2.0 mg/l) indicating non-compliance w.r.t BOD, COD, TDS & SAR discharge norms.
5. The ETP treated effluent is discharged into the municipal drain which meets Buddha Nala and finally Sutlej River.
6. The hazardous waste storage yard was blocked by coal and empty barrels/drums was found stored just outside the storage yard. The sludge in HDPE bags was stored at the area adjacent to sludge dewatering unit.

7. The environmental data display board was found installed and updated.

It is evident that the Unit is non-complying with the effluent discharge standards w.r.t BOD, COD, TDS & SAR parameters prescribed under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.

Now Therefore, in view of the above and in exercise of the power delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is served herewith to show cause why the unit [M/s Oriental Textile Processing Co. Pvt Ltd., Ludhiana East] should not be closed down till it complies with the following directions:

1. The unit shall carry out adequacy assessment of its ETP from reputed institutes/organization within 30 days including treated effluent analysis report from E(P)A approve lab & accordingly upgrade/augment the ETP so as to meet effluent discharge standards & submit the report to CPCB.
2. The floating materials removed from the screens at ETP shall be disposed/ managed in a scientific manner.
3. The Unit shall store the sludge and empty chemical containers at a dedicated covered storage yard/area as per the provisions of Hazardous & other Waste Rules, 2016.
4. The Unit shall install electromagnetic flow meter at ETP outlet and maintain logbook of effluent discharge.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above proposed notice within 15 days from the receipt of this direction, failing which it will be presumed that you have nothing to say and appropriate action, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, will be taken against the Unit without giving any further notice.
