Direction issued under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986- reg.

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s S.K.S. Leather Finishers (Benefit Tanning Industries), 175/158, B- 4, Budhiyaghat, Jajmau, Kanpur- 208 010 (UP) (here in after referred as the "Unit"), is a leather processing Unit; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 23.05.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit to comply with the following directions:

1. The Unit shall stop all manufacturing operations immediately till the installation and commissioning of the online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and provide connectivity to the CPCB server for continuous 24x7 data transmission.
2. The Unit shall report to CPCB about stopping of manufacturing operations immediately.
3. The Unit shall seek permission from CPCB before the resumption of manufacturing operation.

AND WHEREAS, CBCB issued direction dated 28.06.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit to comply with the following directions:

1. The Unit shall remain closed.
2. The Unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operation and compliance of directions.
3. The Unit shall install Flow meter and Camera at its ETP and, shall provide 24 x 7 data transmission facilities to CPCB and UPPCB.

4. The Unit shall not commence operation without setting up Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) and compliance of the effluent parameters.
5. The Unit shall not commence operation without providing data connectivity to CPCB server.
6. The Unit shall not commence operations without taking consents and hazardous waste authorization from State Pollution Control Board.
7. The Unit shall maintain proper logbooks for all the relevant activities.
8. The Unit shall obtain permission from CPCB before resumption of any manufacturing operations.

AND WHEREAS, the Unit replies dated 15.02.2022 and 21.04.2022, were examined and the following observations were made:

- i. The Unit has informed to UPPCB, vide letter dated 23.08.2017, regarding closure of operations.
- ii. The Unit has submitted the self-certificate dated 06.03.2020; snapshot of registration on RTDMS Portal; URL, ID & password for OCEMS connectivity; PETP adequacy assessment report prepared by HBTU, Kanpur; copy of application seeking Consent to operate under Water Act, 1974; Air Act, 1981 and Hazardous Waste Authorization.
- iii. As per the adequacy report, PETP is adequate to treat effluent 1.5m³/hr (18.55m³/day, based on 12hours/day operation). The Unit has installed filter press as recommended in adequacy report.
- iv. The Unit has also submitted coloured photographs of flowmeters, PETP and sludge handling system.
- v. The Unit has requested for the revoke of closure directions issued by CPCB.

AND WHEREAS, OCEMS Connectivity and RTDMS registration of the Unit was verified by IT Division CPCB on 19.5.2022. As per IT Division-CPCB report dated 20.5.22 the Unit was found registered on RTDMS portal and OCEMS connected, however, data was not push to CPCB server; and

WHEREAS, CPCB constituted Four-member committee vide office order dated 25.02.2020 having representatives from CPCB, MoEF&CC and NMCG for examination and recommendation for revoke of the closure directions; and


WHEREAS, the Committee in its meeting, held on 08.06.2022 examined the replies of the Unit, IT division CPCB report and recommended for revocation of closure directions issued to the Unit, with the following conditions:

1. The Unit shall resume its manufacturing operations only after obtaining valid Consent to Operate (CTO) under the Water Act, 1974 and the Air Act, 1981 and Authorization under Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016, from Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
2. The Unit shall communicate the date of commencement of operations to CPCB and revocation of closure directions shall be for an initial period of three months after the commencement of the operations, and in case of compliance of the discharge norms as per prescribed standards, further revocation would be deemed as having been granted.
3. The Unit shall submit performance assessment report of the effluent treatment system (PETP) including analysis report of treated effluent, within 60days from resumption of operations.
4. The Unit shall ensure continuous operation of OCEMS and un-interrupted transmission of data to CPCB server.

AND NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, CPCB directions dated 23.05.2017 and 28.06.2017 are hereby revoked and **M/s S.K.S. Leather Finishers (Benefit Tanning Industries), 175/158, B- 4, Budhiyaghat, Jajmau, Kanpur- 208 010 (UP)**, is directed to comply with the following:

1. The Unit shall resume its manufacturing operations only after obtaining valid Consent to Operate (CTO) under the Water Act, 1974 & the Air Act, 1981 and Authorization under Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016, from Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
2. The Unit shall communicate to CPCB, the date of commencement of the operations and revocation of closure directions shall be for an initial period of three months after the commencement of the operations, and in case of compliance of the discharge norms as per prescribed standards, further revocation would be deemed as having been granted.
3. The Unit shall submit performance assessment report of the primary effluent treatment system including analysis report of PETP treated effluent, within 60days from resumption of operations.
4. The Unit shall ensure continuous operation of OCEMS and un-interrupted transmission of data to CPCB server.

In case of failure of compliance with the above directions, the CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
