**CLOSURE DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986 IN CASE OF M/S. SUNSHINE INDUSTRIES (F.R.LEATHER), 59 / A, 150 FEET ROAD, JAJMAU, KANPUR, UP- 208 010.**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under Rule 3 of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tannery and Leather industries are also identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online effluent monitoring system in tannery industries by March 31, 2015;

**WHEREAS** vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014, CPCB clarified the methods for monitoring various prescribed parameters, and further clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of Units with zero liquid discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015, and vide FAQs posted on website of CPCB in September 2015, CPCB clarified the points related to CETP member units that such units shall install online electromagnetic flow meter and web camera; and

**WHEREAS**, considering the requests/ representations received from industries/ industrial associations/ SPCBs/PCCs, an extension of time up to June 30, 2015 for installation of online monitoring systems was granted vide directions dated March 02, 2015 under Section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974; and

**WHEREAS**, a letter vide dated May 29, 2015 was issued by the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) to all the SPCBs/ PCCs informing that no further extension of time will be given after June 30, 2015 and withdrawal of consent to operate along with forfeiture of bank guarantee of non-complying units will be the only option; and

**WHEREAS**, concerned SPCB/ PCC have issued directions under section 33A of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 to install the online monitoring system by June 30, 2015 and to submit Bank Guarantee of 100% of the cost of online effluent monitoring system; and

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**WHEREAS**, in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, a Show-cause Notice for Closure cum Directions vide letter dated 22.7.2015 was issued to the tannery industries for non-installation of online effluent monitoring system by June 30, 2015 and also directed for ensuring compliance within 15 days; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Sunshine Industries (F.R. Leather), 59 / A, 150 Feet Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, U.P is required to obtain and comply with the conditions of Consents under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 as well as Authorization granted by the U.P. Pollution Control Board (UPPCB) under the Hazardous and Other Waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules 2016, as applicable; and

**WHEREAS**, the representative (s) of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) carried out inspection of M/s Sunshine Industries (F.R. Leather), 59 / A, 150 Feet Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, U.P (hereafter referred as Unit) on May 26, 2017 for verification of compliance to the norms stipulated under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and visited team observed that

- (a) *Outlet of PETP effluent characteristics observed w.r.to pH: 7.06, Suspended Solids: 280 mg/l, Total Chromium: 6.1 mg/l and the treated effluent is not complying with the effluent discharge norms w.r.to Total Chromium (exceeding the limit of 2 mg/l) as stipulated by UPPCB.*
- (b) *Unit is yet to obtain NOC from CGWA for ground water extraction.*
- (c) *Separate energy meter provided for operation of the PETP, which was not functional during inspection.*
- (d) *No mixing arrangement of chemical or equalization of effluent was available in PETP;*
- (e) *Online flow meter at the out let of PETP installed and provided data connectivity to CPCB but details are not provided on CPCB registration portal even after repeated request by IT Division in CPCB. Also, the online flow meter provided at the outlet of PETP is not tamper proof.*
- (f) *Unit is yet to up-grade its PETP in compliance to the Consent granted by UPPCB to meet the discharge norms.*
- (g) *Hazardous waste such as empty chemical drums etc. is stored indiscriminately and not obtained authorisation for disposal of such hazardous waste.*
- (h) *DG set is not equipped with acoustic enclosure and adequate stack height as required under DG Set norms.*
- (i) *Details on Consents under Water Act & Air Act as well as Authorisation obtained from UPPCB are not provided by the Unit.*
- (j) *Details of Chemicals and its quantities used in the chrome tanning process is not provided by the Unit.*
- (k) *Total water consumption from Tube well as well as wastewater generation quantities is not provided by the unit.*

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.

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**NOW, THEREFORE** in view of the reasons mentioned in earlier paras at Sl. No. (a) to (k) and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Unit (*i.e.*, **M/s Sunshine Industries (F.R. Leather), 59 / A, 150 Feet Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, U.P**) *is hereby directed to close its operation with immediate effect for violation of provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.*

In case, the Unit (*i.e.*, **M/s Sunshine Industries (F.R. Leather), 59 / A, 150 Feet Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, U.P**) fails to comply with these directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate proceedings against the Unit under the provisions of the Environment (P) Act, 1986 and amendments made thereof, without any further notice.
