Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the tannery and leather industries are also identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly in to ambient Air and Water, having potential to threat to cause adverse effects on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, concerned SPCBs/ PCC have issued direction under section 33 A of the Water (Prevention & control of Pollution) Act, 1974 to install the online monitoring system by June 30, 2015 and to submit bank guarantee of 100 % of the cost of online effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, M/s, Nish Enterprises (Saud Tannery), 12/9 Gajjupurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is involve in tanning of leathers (raw to finished); and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 03.04.2017 to verify the compliance status and found non operational; and

WHEREAS, CPCB, IT division has confirmed that the unit has provided data connectivity to CPCB but has not yet completed its registration on CPCB 'Industry registration portal'; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued Show cause notice to the unit dated June 16, 2017 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, unit replied vide letter dated 04.07.2017 in respect of show cause notice & compliance of the direction, and was examined that:

1. Unit has proper connectivity with CPCB server and registered on industry registration portal of CPCB.
2. Unit has valid consent to operate under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 up to 31.12.2018 for processing of 05 hides/day or 125 kg/day maximum.

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AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the above mentioned Show Cause notice dated 16.06.2017 issued to the unit is hereby revoked and shall comply with following directions:

1. Unit shall ensure to provide continuous data connectivity on CPCB server.
2. The unit shall maintain the treatment plant so as to meet the standards as per the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
