Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 - reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause an adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02. 1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Famous Tannery, 163/156, Laltupurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur (UP)-208010 (hereafter referred as 'the Unit'), is a tannery engaged in processing of raw hides to produce finished leather and discharge its PETP treated effluent for further treatment into CETP Jajmau; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued direction dated 24.10.2018 under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit to remain closed and shall provide OCEMS data connectivity with CPCB server and obtain valid Consent to Operate from UPPCB and submit copy to CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Unit replies vide letters dated 20.12.2022 & 14.02.2023 was examined and the following observations were made:

1. The Unit has provided OCEMS URL, User ID, password and screen shot of CPCB registration online portal.
2. The Unit has provided letter dated 25.03.2022 submitted to the UPPCB Regional Officer, Kanpur informing about electricity disconnection and inspection carried out by CPCB authorized Third Party Agency.

3. The Unit has provided self-certificate mentioning letter dated 10-05-2022 issued by UPPCB, confirming that unit was found closed during inspection carried out by Third Party Agency.

AND WHEREAS, the data connectivity with CPCB server was verified by IT-Division, CPCB on 10.01.2023 and was found connected on RTDMS portal; and

WHEREAS, Three Member Committee for revocation in its meeting held on 17.03.2023 discussed the matter and recommended to issue the revoke directions to the unit subject to the following conditions as per the policy guidelines for issuance of directions;

1. The Unit shall be permitted to operate for three months from the date of commencement of operation.
2. The Unit shall obtain the valid Consent under the Water Act, 1974, Air Act, 1981 and Authorization under Hazardous & Other Waste Management Rules, 2016 issued by SPCB and shall not operate without valid Consents.
3. The Unit shall ensure uninterrupted data connectivity of OCEMS with CPCB server after commencement of operation of the plant.
4. The Unit shall ensure periodic calibration of the analysers as per Standard Operating Procedure/ recommendations of the supplier and submit the calibration results.
5. The Unit shall intimate the date of resumption of manufacturing operation to CPCB.
6. In case of compliance of the above conditions during permitted three months from the date of resumption of operation, the revocation direction shall be deemed to be continuing on stipulated conditions.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Closure Directions dated 24.10.2018 is hereby revoked and the Unit, **M/s Famous Tannery, 163/156, Laltapurwa, Jajmau, KANPUR-208010 (UP)** is directed to comply with the following:

1. The Unit shall be permitted to operate for three months from the date of commencement of operation.
2. The Unit shall obtain the valid Consent under the Water Act, 1974; Air Act, 1981 and Authorization under Hazardous & Other Waste Management Rules, 2016 issued by SPCB and shall not operate without valid Consents.
3. The Unit shall ensure uninterrupted data connectivity of OCEMS with CPCB server after commencement of production process operations.
4. The Unit shall ensure periodic calibration of the analysers as per Standard Operating Procedure/ recommendations of the supplier and submit the calibration results.
5. The Unit shall intimate the date of resumption of manufacturing operation to CPCB.
6. In case of compliance of the above conditions during permitted three months from the date of resumption of operation, the revocation direction shall be deemed to be continuing on stipulated conditions.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions by the Unit, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the Unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
