**Show Cause Notice under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

**WHEREAS**, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the Rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

**WHEREAS**, an application was filed in Hon'ble NGT Principal Bench by Sh. Aditya Singh Chauhan regarding use of pet coke and ceramic tiles dust for heating of the boilers by the textile industries at Ahmedabad and Narol in Gujarat and Pali in Rajasthan. Further, it was also complained that hot boiler waste is improperly discharged on barren land leading to heaps of mounds of ash, which in turn generate air pollution; and

**WHEREAS**, Hon'ble NGT (PB) in OA no. 233 of 2021, Aditya Singh Chauhan Vs Central Pollution Control Board & Ors. vide order dated 25.11.2021 directed that the applicant should raise the issue first before the CPCB so that CPCB may, in coordination with the State PCBs and after interaction with the stakeholders, take a call in the matter; and

**WHEREAS**, a meeting was held on 21.01.2022, through Video Conferencing between CPCB, GPCB, and the applicant. It was decided in the meeting that a joint inspection will be carried out by CPCB and GPCB to address the issue raised by the applicant; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s Mahak Synthetics Mills Pvt. Ltd., Plot No.140/1, Piplej Pirana Road, Piplej, GIDC-Narol, Ahmedabad (hereinafter referred as 'the Unit') was inspected by the joint team of CPCB and GPCB on 02.03.2022. CPCB issued closure direction dated 06.07.2022 under

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section 5 of the E(P)Act, 1986 to the Unit based on the observed non-compliances in the inspection report; and

**WHEREAS**, the Unit responded to CPCB closure direction vide its letter dated 25.07.2022, 10.08.2022, 20.10.2022 and has submitted the required compliance's including Adequacy Assessment Report (AAR) of ETP & APCD, however, the Unit did not closed their manufacturing operation. The Unit submitted 'self-certificate' vide its letter dated 15.02.2023 and it was found that the Unit did not closed its operation immediately despite CPCBs closure direction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hon'ble NGT, Principal Bench order dated 31.08.2018 in the matter of O.A. No. 593/2017 (WP(CIVIL) No. 375/2012), Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti & Anr. Vs Union of India & Ors. directed "CPCB to take penal action for failure and, if any, against those accountable for setting up and maintaining STPs, CETPs and ETPs and may also asses and recover compensation for damage to the environment and said fund may be kept in a separate account and utilised in term of an action plan for protection of the environment"; and

**WHEREAS**, in compliance of the Hon'ble NGT order dated 31.08.2018 (O.A. No. 593/2017), a Committee was constituted by CPCB for developing a formula for imposing Environmental Compensation (EC) on industrial Units. As per the Committee recommendations, one of the case to be considered for levying EC is "non-complying with the directions issued such as closure direction"; and

**WHEREAS**, as per the formula derived for EC by CPCB, the total EC amount is calculated to be Rs.81,30,000 (Eighty-one lakh and thirty thousand only) for the total non-compliance period of 271 days, based on the number of days of the violation by the Unit (Date of inspection to till date of compliance of closure direction); and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment, Forest, & Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board, to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission & effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules,1986 and other standards and norms; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, notice is served herewith to show cause why environmental compensation of Rs. 81,30,000 (Eighty-one lakh and thirty thousand only) should not be imposed on M/s Mahak Synthetics Mills Pvt. Ltd., Plot No.140/1, Piplej

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**Dir. u/s 5 of E(P) Act, 1986 to M/s Mahak Synthetics Mills Pvt. Ltd, Ahmedabd**

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Pirana Road, Piplej, GIDC-Narol, Ahmedabad for 271 days of violation based on available record i.e. from date of violation observed till the date of closure of manufacturing operations.

You are hereby given an opportunity to file your objections (if any) to the above proposed direction within 15 days from the receipt of this notice, failing which it will be presumed that you have nothing to say and appropriate action, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, will be taken against the Unit without giving any further notice.
