**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT,
1986**

WHEREAS, Tannery industries have been identified as one of the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharged standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, M/s Zeba Tanners, 180/3, Laltoo Purwa, Jajmau, Kanpur-10, U.P. (hereinafter referred as the 'Unit') is involved in raw hide to leather finishing work; and

WHEREAS, a team of officials deputed by Central Pollution Control Board inspected the unit on March 31, 2017, to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued show cause notice under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 dated 21-06-2017 to the unit; and

WHEREAS, the Unit's reply vide letter dated 10-07-2017 was examined and following observations made:

1. The unit has completed registration at CPCB portal and now OCEMS connectivity with CPCB server is complete.

AND WHEREAS, IT division, CPCB has confirmed that the unit has provided OCEMS data connectivity and registration completed to CPCB server; and


NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit's Show Cause Notice dated 12.06.2017 is revoked herewith and directed to comply with the following direction:

1. The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure compliance with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. At any stage, if the treated effluent does not meet notified discharge standards the unit shall close down manufacturing operations immediately and report to CPCB.
2. The unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.

In case of failure of the unit **M/s Zeba Tanners, 180/3, Laltoo Purwa, Jajmau, Kanpur-10, U.P.** to comply with the norms action as deemed appropriate will be taken under provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
