Sub.: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding

WHEREAS, Dye & Dye Intermediate units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, a direction under section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 was issued on February 05, 2014 to all the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/ Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) for installation of online effluent monitoring system w.r.t.. pH, TSS, BOD, COD, Cr, & Flow parameters in Dye & Dye Intermediate industries; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter & web camera may be installed in case of Units with zero liquid discharge (ZLD) by March 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Central Pollution Control Board, Regional Directorate, Vadodara inspected the unit **M/s Devanshi Dyestuff**, Plot No. 141/2F, GIDC Ankleshwar, Dist Bharuch Gujarat on May 22, 2017 w.r.t offline status of Online Continuous Effluent monitoring System during the period of March 15 to April 15, 2017, to assess the compliance of the existing pollution control measures and observed that unit disposes the treated effluent to Narmada Clean Tech Ltd. CETP; and

WHEREAS, it was observed that treated effluent is exceeding the Gujarat Pollution Control Board Prescribed standards w.r.t. TDS (8964 > 2100 mg/l), COD (608 > 100 mg/l), BOD (103 > 30 mg/l), Phenols (1.652 > 1.0 mg/l), Sulphate (2189 > 1000mg/l), Fluoride (2.33 > 1.5 mg/l) thereby inflicting a grave injury to the environment; and

WHEREAS, on the basis of above stated observations Closure directions under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act 1986, were issued by Central Pollution Control Board on August 04, 2017 to the unit to close down all operational activities with immediate effect; and

WHEREAS, the Unit vide letter dated August 10, 2017 informed that it has received amended consent from GPCB having revised treated effluent norms for members of FETP w.r.t TDS 10000 mg/l, COD 1000 mg/l, BOD 200 mg/l, Phenolic Compounds 5 mg/l, Sulphate 1000 mg/l, Fluoride 15 mg/l.

WHEREAS, the Unit vide letter dated September 01, 2017 submitted the duly notarized undertaking, Treated effluent monitoring laboratory analysis report and requested to revoke the closure direction; and

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WHEREAS, the Unit has informed vide Self certificate dated August 23, 2017 that the unit has stopped production since August 16, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has submitted an undertaking of September 01, 2017 that it has complied with all directions issued by CPCB and if plant is found non-compliant during verification by CPCB officials, the Unit will accept to close down operations immediately and shall not operate till full compliance is achieved; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of notarized undertaking submitted by the unit under reference, the directions issued under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to **M/s Devanshi Dyestuff, Plot No. 141/2F, GIDC Ankleshwar, Dist Bharuch Gujarat- 393002** vide letter dated August 04, 2017 are hereby revoked.

The Unit will ensure compliance with the norms. In case of non-compliance by the Unit; action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
