DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharge standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and the rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, there is a need to inculcate habit of self monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent & emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self monitoring mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'Polluter Pays Principle'; and

WHEREAS, M/s Durgapur Steel Plant, Durgapur-3, Burdwan, West Bengal (hereinafter referred to as 'the unit') is a Iron & steel plant; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected on 26.04.2017 and it was observed that the unit has not provided device ID and registration is incomplete with respect to connectivity of online continuous effluent/emission monitoring system data with CPCB server.; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued Show Cause Notice dated 14.06.2017 under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit;

WHEREAS, the unit's reply vide letter dated 05.07.2017 was examined and found that the unit has completed registration process; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection)

Act, 1986, the Show Cause Notice dated 14.06.2017 is hereby revoked and the unit M/s **Durgapur Steel Plant, Durgapur-3, Burdwan, West Bengal** is directed to comply with the following direction:


1. The Unit shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
2. The Unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
