Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s New Anupam Dyeing & Bleaching, 123/19, Saresh Bagh, Kanpur (U.P.) (here in after referred as 'the unit') is involved in the process of textile, dyeing & printing; and.

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on April 10th, 2017 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB had issued the following directions dated 15th June, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit:

- 1) The unit shall immediately stop all the manufacturing operations till (i) obtaining valid consents from UPPCB (ii) installation & commissioning of online effluent monitoring system and providing connectivity to CPCB server for submission of real time online data.
- 2) The unit shall report to CPCB regarding closure of manufacturing operations in compliance of the direction immediately on receipt of this direction.
- 3) The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of the manufacturing operation.

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated July 20th, 2017 and July 28th, 2017 were examined and following observations made:

- 1) The unit has closed down all its operations.
- 2) The unit has closed down its dyeing and bleaching operations and informed to CPCB, Regional Directorate, Lucknow vide letter dated 11th December, 2015.
- 3) The unit at present is involved in the knitting process only and water is utilized only in domestic processes.
- 4) The unit has applied for UPPCB consent on dated 25th July, 2017.
- 5) The unit has submitted an undertaking that the unit has been engaged in only dry process namely, knitting and weaving since 2015 and has removed all machines related to dyeing and bleaching.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the directions dated June 15th, 2017 is hereby revoked and the unit, **M/s New Anupam Dyeing & Bleaching, 123/19, Saresh Bagh, Kanpur (U.P.)** is directed to comply with the following directions:

- 1) The unit shall operate only dry process namely, knitting and weaving and resume operation only after seeking valid consent under the Water/ Air acts from UPPCB.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
