DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, Tannery industries have been identified as one of the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharged standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, M/s Allied Leathers & Leather Products, 51-A-150 Ft. Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, U.P. (hereinafter referred as the 'Unit') is involved in raw hide to leather finishing work; and

WHEREAS, a team of officials deputed by Central Pollution Control Board inspected the unit on March 29, 2017 and found non-compliance w.r.t. Chromium 6.7 mg/l as against norm of 2 mg/l and OCEMS registration with CPCB online connectivity incomplete; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 dated 12-06-2017 to the unit till compliance of the following:

1. To meet the prescribed standard in terms of chromium for the primary effluent treatment plant.
2. The unit shall complete the registration of OCEMS online connectivity to CPCB server.

WHEREAS, the Unit's reply vide letter dated 18-08-2017 and 24.08.2017 was examined and following observations made:

1. The unit has obtained the membership of Common Chrome Recovery Plant, Nagar Nigam, Kanpur.
2. Any Chrome liquor generated from the unit is stored in two big size tanks in the unit and drain is laid between drum and tank for proper conveyance and storage of chrome liquor and later on disposal to common chrome recovery plant.
3. The unit has assured that this kind of complaint will not be repeated in the future.
4. The OCEMS registration has been completed on 20.01.2017.

AND WHEREAS, the unit has submitted an undertaking on stamp paper; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit's Closure directions dated 12.06.2017 is revoked herewith and the unit is directed to comply with the following direction:

1. The Unit shall operate PETP properly so as to ensure compliance with the prescribed effluent discharge norms. At any stage, if the treated effluent does not meet notified discharge standards the unit shall close down manufacturing operations immediately and report to CPCB.
2. The unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.

In case of failure of the unit **M/s Allied Leathers & Leather Products, 51-A-150 Ft. Road, Jajmau, Kanpur, U.P.** to comply with the norms action as deemed appropriate will be taken under provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
