Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, the Tannery industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s New Light Tanning Industries, 125 Ikbal Street, Jajmau, Distt-Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is involved in the process of raw hides to finished leather; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected on 06/04//2017, by the officials deputed by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), and observed that-

- i. PETP treated (outlet) effluent sample TSS value 760 mg/L (against norm of 600mg/l), and pH 5.25 (against norm of 6.0 to 9.0) which indicates non-compliance with the PETP standard prescribed by UP Pollution Control Board.
- ii. Unit has installed flow meter but failed to show any connectivity with CPCB server.

AND WHEREAS, the CPCB issued closure direction dated 19.05.2017 under section 5 Environment (Protection) to the Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has submitted the letter dated 02.06.2017 mentioning that-

- 1) the unit has closed all manufacturing operations.
- 2) the unit has installed & commissioned online connectivity system.
- 3) the unit has made improvement in PETP for better performance.

AND WHEREAS, the CPCB issued direction dated 30/06/17 to the unit to complying with the following:

- 1) The Unit shall remain closed, until it gets the adequacy assessment report of PETP, by CLRI/ NPC/ IIT Kanpur.
- 2) The Unit shall get permission from CPCB before starting manufacturing operation.

AND WHEREAS, the unit reply letters dated 26.07.2017 & 11.08.2017 were examined and following observations are made.

- i) PETP adequacy report prepared by National Productivity Council (NPC) Kanpur experts. The PETP is found adequate for effluent treatment up to 87.0 KL/day.
- ii) the unit has provided connectivity of OCEMS with the CPCB sewer.
- iii) the unit has submitted copy of consent (valid upto 31.12.2017) under Water Act 1974 and Air Act 1981.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure directions dated 19.05.2017 and 30.06.2017 are revoked and the unit M/s New Light Tanning Industries, 125, Ikbal Street, Jajmau, Distt.-Kanpur (UP) is permitted to operate and directed to comply the following:

The Unit shall take necessary action to ensure that primary treated effluent discharged by the Unit will comply the PETP standards / inlet to CETP standards and the effluent is further treated in the CETP as per CETP effluent standards notified by Central Government vide Gazette notification dated 01.01.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
