DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, Chemical units are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent and emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self-regulatory mechanism, online source emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is obligatory on the part of industries to install effluent treatment plants (ETPs) to comply with the effluent discharged standards as notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under and also to meet the consent conditions granted by State Pollution Control Board (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees (PCCs); and

WHEREAS, M/s Materials Chemicals and Performance Intermediaries Pvt. Ltd., (formerly MCC-PTA Ltd.) Vill & P.O. Bhuniarichak, Haldia, Purba Medinipur-721635, West Bengal (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is involve in manufacturing of inorganic chemicals; and

WHEREAS, the unit was inspected by CPCB officials on 28.04.2017 and found that the unit has provided data connectivity to CPCB server but has not yet completed registration on CPCB's 'Industry Registration Portal'; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued show cause notice dt. 27.06.2017 for not complying with the requirements with CPCB's 'Industry Registration Portal'; and

WHEREAS, the Unit reply vide letters dated 13-07-2017 was examined and found that the unit has provided OCEMS connectivity with CPCB server and completed registration; and

WHEREAS, IT division, CPCB has confirmed that the unit has provided OCEMS data connectivity to CPCB server; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit **M/s Materials Chemicals and Performance Intermediaries Pvt. Ltd., (formerly MCC-PTA Ltd.) Vill & P.O. Bhuniarichak, Haldia, Purba Medinipur-721635, West Bengal** Show cause notice dated 27.06.2017 is revoked herewith and directed to comply with the following direction:

1. The unit shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
2. The unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
