**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986**

**WHEREAS**, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ministry of Environment, Forest, & Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board, to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and other standards and norms; and

**WHEREAS**, M/s JK Paper Ltd., Jaykapur, District-Raygada, Odisha (*hereafter referred to as 'the Unit'*) is an integrated pulp & paper mill with an installed capacity of 3,00,000 TPA paper manufacturing writing & printing paper, photocopier paper, paperboards, bond paper and coated paper using Hard wood and Bamboo as raw material; and

**WHEREAS**, the Unit was inspected by a team of officials from CPCB on March 01, 2017 to verify the compliance status and following observations were made:

1. The Unit & its ETP was in operation.
2. The Unit has valid Consent under Water/Air Act, Hazardous Rule and Biomedical waste and valid upto 31.03.2018, 31.03.2021 & 31.03.2019 respectively.
3. The ETP treated final effluent result showed compliance with the notified discharge norm.
4. Stack emission monitoring of coal fired boiler shows non-compliance with Particulate Matter (PM) value as 65 mg/Nm<sup>3</sup> & 58 mg/Nm<sup>3</sup> (*against OSPCB norms-50 mg/Nm<sup>3</sup>*).
5. The Units real-time OCEMS is connected to CPCB server and variation was observed with BOD (45.1%), COD (18.3%) & TSS (26.35%) between online OCEMS data and CPCB lab data.
6. The online continuous emission monitoring system in the stack attached with lime kiln will be operational by July 2017.

**AND WHEREAS**, CPCB issued show cause notice(SCN) for closure dated 20.04.2017 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to **M/s JK Paper Mill**, Raygada, Odisha; and

**WHEREAS**, the Unit replied vide letter dated 09.05.2017 which was examined; and

**WHEREAS**, the Unit was re-inspected by CPCB team on 12.07.2017 to verify the compliance status and made the following observations:

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1. The Unit and its ETP was in operation.
2. The Unit has valid Consent under Water/Air Act, and Authorization under Hazardous Rule & Biomedical waste which is valid up to 31.03.2018, 31.03.2021 & 31.03.2019 respectively.
3. The ETP treated final effluent sample analysis showed pH-7.19 (*against the norm of 6.5-8.5*), BOD-18 mg/l (*norms-30mg/l*), COD-186 mg/l(*norms350mg/l*), TSS-25 mg/l(*norms-50 mg/l*) which indicates compliance with prescribed effluent discharges norms.
4. Online reading at final outlet showed pH-7.5, BOD-18.8 mg/l, COD-188.9 mg/l,TSS-31.8mg/l which indicates minor variation between manual lab data & OCEMS data. The Unit has re-calibrated all sensor on 8.5.2017.
5. Stack monitoring was carried for coal fired boiler (165 TPH) in both passes (A&B) and observed emission for pass A - **34** mg/Nm<sup>3</sup> & pass B - **43** mg/Nm<sup>3</sup> (combined emission value **38.5** mg/Nm<sup>3</sup> *against stipulated norms-50 mg/Nm<sup>3</sup>*) indicates compliance with prescribed OSPCB norms.
6. Online CEMS in the stack attached with lime kiln has been installed on 20.06.2017.

**It is evident from the above observations that the Unit has complied with prescribed effluent & emission discharge norms.**

**AND NOW, THEREFORE**, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment(Protection)Act,1986, **the aforesaid show cause notice for closure issued to M/s JK Paper Mill, Raygada, Odisha vide letter dated 20.04.2017 under section 5 of Environment(Protection) Act,1986 is hereby revoked.**

In case of default in compliance with prescribed standards, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
