Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 regarding installation of on-line effluent and emission monitoring system-reg

WHEREAS, the Pharmaceutical industries are identified as one of the 17 categories of highly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Sterides Shasun Ltd., Tamilnadu (herein after referred as the Unit) has installed online monitoring system w.r.t CPCB direction letter no. B-29016/04/06/IPC-I/6821 dated July 27, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Online Monitoring System installed at the unit was in offline mode during the month of March-April, 2017; and

WHEREAS the Unit was inspected by a team of official(s) from the CPCB Regional Directorate, Bangalore on July 25, 2017 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures and online effluent monitoring system, observations of team are as follows:

1. The Unit has installed the Online Emission and Effluent Monitoring System and connected with Tamilnadu Pollution Control Board Server and the connectivity has not been provided to CPCB.
2. The housekeeping is poor in boiler and Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) area.

WHEREAS, the connectivity of online data submitted by the Unit was verified by the IT division date August 09, 2017 and it was observed that no connectivity Online Effluent Monitoring System has provided to CPCB by the Unit; and

WHEREAS, a closure direction was issued to the Unit under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, as the following:

- 1) The Unit shall close all the plant operations with immediate effect and shall not resume till;
  - i. The unit provides the Online Emission and Effluent Monitoring System data connectivity to CPCB.
  - ii. The Unit improves housekeeping in the premises.


WHEREAS, the Unit vide letter dated August 24, 2017 submitted the online connectivity status to CPCB and requested to revoke the closure direction; and

WHEREAS, the connectivity of online data submitted by the Unit was verified by the IT division and compliance was observed on August 29, 2017 by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the Unit has stopped production from August 28, 2016 in reference to the CPCB closure direction dated August 16, 2016 as per the original self certificate dated August 28, 2017 submitted by the Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof.


NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of powers vested to Chairman CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and in view of undertaking of compliance submitted by the Unit with relevant direction under reference, the direction issued under the Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit (M/s. Sterides Shasun Ltd., Tamilnadu) vide letter dated August 16, 2017 is hereby revoked. The Unit will ensure compliance with the norms. In case of non-compliance by the Unit action as deemed fit under the provisions of Environment (P) Act, 1986 shall be taken.
