Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the general discharge standards of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under;

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s J.S. Yarn Textile Pvt. Ltd., UPSIDC-ROOMA, Kanpur (U.P.) (here in after referred as 'the unit') is involved in the process of textile, dyeing & printing; and.

WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on April 21st, 2017 to check the status of compliance of prescribed norms; and

WHEREAS, CPCB had issued the following directions dated May 15th, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit:

- 1) The unit shall stop all wet process operations till installation and commissioning of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and provide connectivity to the CPCB server for continuous 24 X 7 data transmission.
- 2) The unit shall report to CPCB about stopping of wet process operations immediately.
- 3) The unit shall seek permission from CPCB before resumption of wet process operation.

AND WHEREAS, CPCB had issued the following directions dated June 14th, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit:

- 1) The unit is directed to close down its operation with immediate effect due to non-compliance of effluent standards.

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WHEREAS, the unit has replied vide letter dated June 1st, 2017 in respect of the directions that:

- 1) The unit has installed webcamera and flowmeter and connected it to CPCB server.
- 2) The unit has submitted an undertaking that the unit is connected with the CETP, UPSIDC, ROOMA, Kanpur.

WHEREAS, UPSIDC vide their letter dated 14th August, 2017 informed that maintenance work of CETP, ROOMA, Kanpur has been completed for commissioning and requested for allowing resumption of operations of the member units for availability of effluent for trial run of CETP.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure directions dated May 15th, 2017 and June 14th, 2017 issued to the unit, **M/s J.S. Yarn Textile Pvt. Ltd., UPSIDC-ROOMA, Kanpur (U.P.)** are **hereby revoked** and the unit is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit is directed to maintain its discharge limit upto 12 KLD and dyeing (production) limit upto 240 kg/day for the above mentioned duration.
2. The unit shall ensure the proper operation of the Primary Effluent Treatment Plant so as to discharge the effluent into the effluent conveyance system to reach the CETP and meet the inlet standards of CETP as mentioned in gazette dated 1st June, 2016.
3. The unit shall ensure continuous transmission of data to CPCB server.
4. The unit shall ensure conveyance of PETP treated effluent to CETP and also proper operation and maintenance of CETP.

In case of non-compliance of the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate action against the unit without giving any further notice in accordance with the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
