Closure Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile dyeing and bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring within the industries for complying with the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online effluent & emission monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s. Chawla Textiles, 92-A, Co-operative Industrial State, Dada Nagar, Kanpur-22, Uttar Pradesh, (herein after referred as the Unit) is involved in the processing of Hosiery clothes; and

WHEREAS, CPCB served show cause notice dated 30.07.2015, to the unit, that why the unit should not be closed down if the unit has not complied fully with the direction issued w. r. t. installation of Online Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS) and further direction to comply with; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 25.07.2016 to the unit to not to undertake any manufacturing operations till installation and commissioning of online 24 x 7 monitoring system and transmission of data to SPCBs/ PCCs and CPCB; and

WHEREAS, the unit reply vide letter dated 09.08.2017 was examined and following observations made;

- i. The unit has installed OCEMS and provide connectivity with CPCB server.
- ii. The unit has given self-certificate declaring that the unit was closed during 29.10.2016 to 03.11.2016 in compliance of CPCB direction dated 25.07.2016 and thereafter the unit is in operation.

AND WHEREAS, inspection of the unit was conducted on May 24, 2017 by a joint team of CPCB and UPPCB officials and following observations are made;

1. At the time of inspection, the unit was in operation, which is in violence of CPCB direction dated 25.07.2016 issued under Section 5 of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986.
2. At the time of inspection, the unit was engaged in process of washing, bleaching and dyeing of cotton cloths with installed capacity of 300-400 Kg/Day.
3. The unit is non-compliance w. r. t. effluent discharged standards (TDS=2950mg/l against norm of 2100mg/l, COD=381mg/l against norm of 250mg/l, BOD=261mg/l against norm of 30mg/l, Phenol as C₆H₅OH=1.15mg/l against norm of 1mg/l, and Oil & Grease=10.5mg/l against norm of 10mg/l).
4. Treated effluent from Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) is discharged into Panki Drain, which meets Pandu River and ultimately joins into River Ganga.
5. No web Camera is provided at the ETP outlet.
6. The unit has not made proper arrangement for storage of its sludge generated from Sludge drying Beds (SDBs). The sludge collected from the SDBs stored in the poly begs and kept in open without shade.
7. The unit does not have valid consent under Water Act, 1974 as well as under Air Act, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the unit was found in operation which is in violation of CPCB direction dated 25.07.2016 issued under Section 5 of Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, for which appropriate legal action shall be initiated separately; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit is hereby directed to close down all manufacturing operations immediately till compliance of following directions;

- i. The unit shall carryout augmentation and upgradation of ETP system for treatment of generated wastewater so as to meet the prescribed effluent discharge norms and shall submit the time bound action plant to CPCB.
- ii. The unit shall install web Camera at the ETP outlet.
- iii. The unit shall make covered area for Storage of its sludge generated from ETP.
- iv. The unit shall obtain valid consents to operate and submit copy to CPCB
- v. The unit remain close until permitted by the CPCB.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, appropriate actions against the unit, M/s. Chawla Textiles, 92-A, Co-operative Industrial State, Dada Nagar, Kanpur-22, Uttar Pradesh will be initiated without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
