Revoke Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the tannery and leather industries are also identified as one of the Grossly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly in to ambient Air and Water, having potential to threat to cause adverse effects on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s Crescent Tanners (Unit -II) D-17, Leather Complex, Site-II, Unnao (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Tannery industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 30.03.2017 to verify the compliance status; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction on dated June 28th, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for not having valid consent at the time of inspection as well as the registration of the OCEMS with the CPCB portal ; and

WHEREAS, unit vide letter 13.07.2017 submitted the registration of the OCEMS with the CPCB portal and provide the connectivity with CPCB server. The unit has submitted the copy of consents with validity till 30.6.2017 and applied for the consents under Water and Air Acts.

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AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated June 28th, 2017 is hereby revoked and the unit is directed to operate as per the consent conditions.

The unit shall ensure proper operation of PETP so as to achieve the prescribed standards and continuous transmission of data to CPCB

In case of default in compliance with the above directions or any other exigencies, CPCB will be constrained to initiate further stringent action against the unit (M/s Crescent Tanners (Unit -II) D-17, Leather Complex, Site-II, Unnao) in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without any further notice.
