Foreword

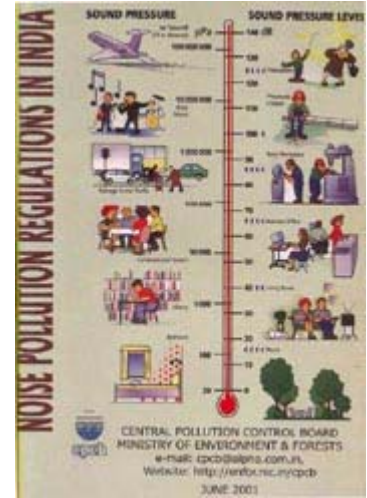
Noise causes health effects, as also socio-cultural and economic effects. Most of the time, its effects cannot be evaluated objectively.
