Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, the tannery and leather industries are also identified as one of the Grossly polluting industries which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly in to ambient Air and Water, having potential to threat to cause adverse effects on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, M/s Safique Split Work, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') is a Tannery industry and was inspected by a team of officials authorized by CPCB on 29.03.2017 to verify the compliance status; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated June 29, 2017 under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for not complying with prescribed norms of TSS; and

WHEREAS, the unit vide letter dated 11.08.2017 & 26.08.2017 has submitted a notarised affidavit indicating that the unit is complying with the CPCB norms and has taken following measures for compliance with the norms;

1. Installed screens on drains and chambers to reduce TSS load discharge into collection tank and settling tank,
2. Increased alum dosing for proper coagulating and flocculation for efficient settling.

3. Reduced the effluent lifting pump capacity to reduce pressure during lifting of effluent from collection tank to settling tank to increase the TSS settling time.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the closure direction dated June 29, 2017 is hereby revoked and the unit is directed to operate as per the consent conditions.

The unit shall ensure proper operation of PETP so as to achieve the prescribed standards and continuous transmission of data to CPCB.


In case of default in compliance with the above directions or any other exigencies, CPCB will be constrained to initiate further stringent action against the unit (Safique Split Work, Jajmau, Kanpur) in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without any further notice.
