**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT,
1986**

WHEREAS, Tannery industries have been identified as one of the Grossly Polluting Industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of emission and effluent standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, a team of officials deputed by Central Pollution Control Board inspected **M/s Laiq Tanners (Formerly Known as Madina Traders) 117/124, Gajjapurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh** (herein after referred as the Unit) on March 28, 2017 to assess the adequacy of the existing pollution control measures; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure directions dt. 14.06.2017 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the unit; and

WHEREAS, the unit replies vide letters dated 05.07.2017, 01.08.2017, 10.08.2017 and 24.08.2017 were examined and following observations made:

1. The unit has submitted a copy of valid consent upto 31.12.2018.
2. The unit has installed a drum in settling tank for improvement of TSS and also provide net on drains.
3. There is no ZLD plan for Jajmau, Kanpur industries.
4. The unit has completed registration of the unit at CPCB portal.
5. The unit has submitted an undertaking on stamp paper with duly notarised/signed by Oath Commissioner that the unit has complied all the directions issued by the CPCB.

AND WHEREAS, IT division, CPCB has confirmed that the unit has provided OCEMS data connectivity to CPCB server; and

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act,

1986, the closure directions dt. 14.06.2017 is hereby revoked and the unit is directed to comply with the following directions:

1. The unit namely **M/s Laiq Tanners (Formerly Known as Madina Traders) 117/124, Gajjupurwa, Jajmau, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh** shall resume operation and shall treat their effluent to meet the effluent discharge standards as notified under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
2. The unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action without any further notice, in accordance with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
