DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT, 1986

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India, vide notification S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 has delegated powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), to issue direction to any industry, Municipal Corporation, Municipal Council, Cantonment Board to any local or other Authority for the violation of emission and effluent standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and other standards and norms; and

WHEREAS, M/s Fibre Marx Papers Private Ltd., 7 km. Stone Haldua Shahu, Kasipur- Jaspur Road, Kashipur (Udham Singh Nagar) Uttarakhand (hereinafter referred as 'the Unit') is a waste paper based mill; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by the officials of CPCB on December 27, 2017 and the unit found non complying; and

WHEREAS, the unit was issued direction dated 18.04.2017 under section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for compliance following directions:

1. To submit and implement a time bound action plan for augmentation/ up gradation of ETP so as to meet the prescribed effluent discharge norms.
2. The unit will submit action taken report along with ETP adequacy assessment report by reputed institution like CPPRI, IITs to CPCB within 30 days.

AND WHEREAS, the units reply vide letter dated 18.05.2017 was examined and following observations made:

1. Mill has provided air mixing arrangement in equalization tank
2. The unit has installed 02 numbers of Micron filter.
3. The unit has provided calibration certificate from recognized lab.
4. The unit has provided adequacy report from CPPRI and compliance of time bound action plan.

AND WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected by the officials of CPCB on July 11, 2017 and made following observations:

Cont.....

1. The unit was found operational during the inspection.
2. The unit consists of Equalization tank, Primary clarifier- I, Aeration Tank, Secondary Clarifier I, Dual media filter, micron-filter & Sludge drying bed. The unit has made arrangements for air bubblers in equalization Tank.
3. The treated effluent is discharged into the Chorkhala drain from where it meets River Dhela to River Ram Ganga.
4. The fresh water consumption and discharge is about 12 m³/Ton & 8.19 m³/Ton of paper produced respectively.
5. The flow at the outlet of ETP was 42.21 m³/h (1013 KLD).
6. The unit has installed two bore well for extraction of ground water and applied for the permission from the CGWA (Copy enclosed).
7. The unit's consent expired from 31.03.2017, and has re applied on dated 12.06.2017.
8. The lab report of ETP treated effluent shows – pH- 7.59; TSS- 10 mg/l (as against norms of 50.0 mg/l); BOD- 03 mg/l (as against norms of 30.0 mg/l); COD- 09 mg/l (as against norms of 30.0 mg/l).

In view of the above observations the unit found complying with effluent discharge norms.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above observations and in exercise of the powers, delegated to the Chairman, CPCB under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the **show cause notice** dated 18.04.2017 issued to **M/s Fibremarx Papers Private Ltd., Kashipur (Udham Singh Nagar) Uttarakhand** is hereby **revoked** and directed to comply with following directions:

1. The unit shall operate only after obtaining valid consent to operate under Water/Air Acts from UEPPCB, Uttarakhand.
2. The unit shall provide data continuously on CPCB server for Online Continuous Effluent Monitoring System (OCEMS).
3. The unit shall operate ETP so as to meet the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

In case of default in compliance with the above directions CPCB will be constrained to initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
