**DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) ACT,
1986**

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S. O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S. O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued show cause notice for closure dated 21.06.2016 to the unit in compliance to directions issued by CPCB under Section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 in respect of GPI with respect to installation of online effluent monitoring system; and

WHEREAS, M/s Asia Tannery Private Limited, 1/A, Jajmau, Kanpur, U.P. (hereafter referred to as the 'Unit') was inspected on 30.03.2017 by team of officials authorized by CPCB; and

WHEREAS, CPCB issued show cause notice under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 dated 27-06-2017 to the unit till compliance of the following:

1. Unit shall ensure to provide continuous flow data on CPCB server and registration on industrial registration portal within 15 days.
2. The unit shall maintain the treatment plant so as to meet the CETP inlet norms as per the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, the Unit's reply vide letter dated 18-07-2017 was examined and following observations are made:

1. The unit has installed on online flow meter monitoring system and the same has been linked to CPCB & UPPCB servers. Registration of OCEMS is completed.
2. The unit has installed PETP and Chrome Recovery Plant, which is being operated and maintained regularly.
3. The unit has authorisation from UPPCB to store solid waste generated from PETP. Unit's solid waste is disposed a authorized TSDF.
4. As a member of CETP the unit is regularly paying contribution towards maintenance and operation charges.

AND NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above mentioned observations and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman CPCB, under section 5 of the Environment (Protection)

Act, 1986, the unit's show cause notice dated 27.06.2017 is revoked herewith and directed to comply with the following direction:

1. The Unit shall operate ETP properly so as to ensure compliance with the effluent discharge norms notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. At any stage, if the treated effluent does not meet notified discharge standards the unit shall close down manufacturing operations immediately and report to CPCB.
2. The unit shall ensure continuous connectivity with CPCB server.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB will be constrained to initiate action against the Unit namely **M/s Asia Tannery Private Limited, 1/A, Jajmau, Kanpur, U.P.**, in accordance with the provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, without giving any further notice.
