Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 –reg.

WHEREAS, the central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries under Rule 3 of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 Whereas all industries are required to install and regularly operate the requisite pollution control facilities to comply with the standards for discharge of environmental pollutants; and

WHEREAS, the Textile industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No.S.O.157(E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O.730(E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, it was clarified that flow meter and web camera may be installed in case of units achieving zero liquid discharge ZLD by march 31, 2015 vide guidelines uploaded on website of CPCB dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, M/s Standard Niwar Mills, D-24, Site 1, Panki Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, (here in after referred as 'the Unit') is textile unit and ;

WHEREAS, a team deputed by CPCB carried out inspection of M/s Standard Niwar Mills, D-24, Site 1, Panki Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh, on dated 05.04.2017.

WHEREAS, CPCB issued closure direction dated 30.05.2017 under section 5 of Environment (P) to the Unit and;

WHEREAS, the unit's letter dated 24/08/2017 was examined and following observations made:

1. As informed by the proponent unit, the operation was closed down since last 18th months.
2. The unit has not installed OCEMS.
3. The unit is not having valid consent under Water Act 1974 and Air Act 1981.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the unit is hereby directed to comply with the following directions.

1. The Unit, , **M/s Standard Niwar Mills, D-24, Site 1, Panki Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh**, shall remain closed and not to resume manufacture operation till compliance with the directions dated 30.05.2017.
2. The unit shall install OCEMS and will register for connectivity to CPCB portal.
3. The unit shall submit valid consent under Air Act and Water Act from UPPCB.

In case of default in compliance with the above directions, CPCB may initiate appropriate actions against the unit, without giving any further notice, in accordance with provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
