Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- Revoke reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries (GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Rupesh Kumar & Brothers, (hereafter referred as 'the Unit'), is a Textile industry located at Plot No.65, 66, 73 & 74, BIDA Carpet City Bhadohi, UP -221401; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected on 21/03/2017, by the officials deputed by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), and observed that-

- i. Unit has not installed flow meter at water source and OCEMS at ETP outlet.
- ii. ETP treated (outlet) effluent sample was found non-complying w.r.t. notified effluent discharge standards, with TDS 2143 mg/l (against norm of 2100mg/L), BOD 39.4 mg/l (against norm of 30mg/L).

WHEREAS, CBCB issued closure direction dated 15.05.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit to close down till installation of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and connectivity with CPCB/ SPCB; and

WHEREAS, CBCB issued closure direction dated 31.05.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to the Unit, for non-compliance w.r.t. standards for discharge of effluent; and

WHEREAS, the unit's reply vide letters dated 10/07/2017 and 25/07/2017 were examined and the following observations are made-

- i) the unit has installed OCEMS, provided connectivity with CPCB server.
- ii) the unit has submitted self certificate mentioning that it has stopped the operations with effect from 21.06.2017.
- iii) the unit has submitted notarized Affidavit dated 27.07.2017, that unit shall limit their production(wool yarn dyeing) up to 2500 kg/day, so that process effluent does not exceed the consented trade effluent discharge 150KL per day and shall not discharge any untreated / partially treated effluent.
- iv) the unit has consent (valid up to 31.12.2017) for trade effluent discharge of 150KL/day, under the Water Act 1974, issued by the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
- v) the unit has ETP system of 19.0 KL/ hour capacity consisting of Screen, O/G Trap, Equalization tank, Physico-chemical treatment (Chemicals dosing, mixing tanks, Tube settler), Aeration tank and Secondary settler, followed by Filtration (PSF and ACF), Sludge Drying Beds and Filter press (for dewatering of sludge).

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the closure directions dated 15.05.2017 and 31.05.2017 are revoked and the unit M/s Rupesh Kumar & Brothers Factory Plot No.65, 66, 73 & 74, BIDA Carpet City Bhadohi, Uttar Pradesh- 221401, is permitted to resume the production and hereby directed to comply with the following conditions -


- I.** the Unit shall resume the manufacturing operations and inform immediately to the CPCB; and
- II.** the unit shall not exceed the consented trade effluent discharge 150KL per day; and
- III.** the Unit shall not discharge any untreated / partially treated effluent and shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent for Textile industries as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
