Sub: Directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986- Revoke reg.

WHEREAS, the Textile, Dyeing & Bleaching industries are identified as one of the Grossly Polluting industries(GPIs) which have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the ambient air and water, having potential threat to cause adverse effect on the water and air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, vide Notifications No. S.O. 157 (E) of 27.02.1996 and S.O. 730 (E) dated 10.07.2002, has delegated the powers vested under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board, to issue directions to any industry or any local body or any other authority for violations of the standards and rules notified under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and amendment thereof; and

WHEREAS, M/s Raj Dyers (hereafter referred as 'the Unit'), is a Textile industry located at Pump House Road, Mamdevpur, Bhadohi (U.P.)- 221401; and

WHEREAS, the Unit was inspected on 22/03/2017, by the officials deputed by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), and observed that-

- i. Unit has not installed flow meter at water source and OCEMS at ETP outlet.
- ii. Unit has not obtained permission from CGWA for extraction of ground water.

WHEREAS, CBCB issued closure direction dated 01.05.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit to close down till installation of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and connectivity with CPCB/ SPCB; and

WHEREAS, CBCB issued closure direction dated 15.05.2017, under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986; to the Unit to close down till installation of online continuous effluent monitoring system (OCEMS) and connectivity with CPCB/ SPCB; and

WHEREAS, the unit's reply vide letters dated 11/07/2017, 27/07/2017 and 08.09.2017 were examined and the following observations made-

- 1) the unit has installed OCEMS, provided connectivity with CPCB server.
- 2) the unit has submitted self certificate mentioning that it has stopped the operations with effect from 02.06.2017.
- 3) the unit has submitted notarized Affidavit dated 27.07.2017, that unit shall shall not discharge untreated / partially treated effluent.

- 4) The unit has submitted notarized Affidavit dated 14.09.2017 in the required format.
- 5) the unit has consent (valid up to 31.12.2017) for trade effluent discharge of 80KL/day, under the Water Act 1974, issued by the Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board.
- 6) the unit has ETP system of 10.0KL/ hour capacity consisting of Screen, O/G Trap, Equalization tank, Physico-chemical treatment (Chemicals dosing, mixing tanks, Tube settler), Aeration tank and Secondary settler, followed by Filtration (PSF and ACF), Sludge Drying Beds and Filter press (for dewatering of sludge).

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the above and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the closure directions dated 01.05.2017 and 15.05.2017 are revoked and the unit M/s Raj Dyers, Pump House Road, Mamdevpur, Bhadohi (U.P.)-221401, is permitted to resume the production and hereby directed to comply with the following –

- I.** the Unit shall resume the manufacturing operations and inform immediately to CPCB; and
- II.** the Unit shall ensure all time compliance of the standards of treated effluent for Textile industries as per Gazette notification dated 10.10.2016 under Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.

In case of failure of the unit to comply with the directions, action will be taken in accordance with the provisions under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
